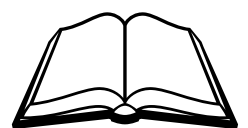

LIGHT A CANDLE AT ST. MARY MAGDALENE

"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life." John 8:12

One of the most iconic sites in Catholic Churches throughout the world are stands of votive candles. Lit for intercessions, or to remember a loved one, these candles burn day and night as a sign of the impassioned prayer of those who lit them.

In most every part of Catholic celebrations and rituals, lighting of candles plays a very significant role. Candles are lit during the celebration of the Mass, on liturgical and funeral processions and evening prayer ceremonies. Candles are lit before the Tabernacle to signify the Lord's presence in the Blessed Sacrament and to call for reverence on the part of the faithful.

Catholics light candles to pray for their deceased loves ones, the sick, the health and welfare of family and friends, and for the needs of our worldwide family. In the lighting of candles, we not only pray, but our prayers become symbols of the One Light of Christ, "the Light of the World."

The light also shows a special reverence and our desire to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart and go about our daily business.

We encourage a donation of \$3.00 per candle to assist with the costs of maintaining the candles.
