EL SIGNIFICADO DEL JUEVES SANTO

A excepción de la resurrección en Pascua, el Jueves Santo es posiblemente uno de los días de celebración más importantes, complejos y profundos en la Iglesia Católica. El Jueves Santo celebra la institución de la Eucaristía como el verdadero cuerpo y sangre de Jesucristo y la institución del sacramento del sacerdocio. Durante la Última Cena, Jesús se ofrece a sí mismo como el sacrificio de la Pascua, el cordero sacrificial, y enseña que cada sacerdote ordenado debe seguir el mismo sacrificio exactamente de la misma manera. Cristo también se despide de sus seguidores y profetiza que uno de ellos lo traicionará y lo entregará a los soldados romanos.

Después de la puesta del sol, porque la Pascua comenzaba a la puesta del sol, tiene lugar la Liturgia del Jueves Santo, que marca el final de la Cuaresma y el comienzo del sagrado "Triduo", o tres, de la Semana Santa. Estos días son los tres días más sagrados de la Iglesia Católica.

Esta Misa subraya la importancia que Jesús da a la humildad del servicio y a la necesidad de la limpieza con agua, símbolo del bautismo. También se subraya la importancia crítica de la Eucaristía y del sacrificio del Cuerpo de Cristo, que ahora encontramos presente en la Hostia consagrada.

Al final de la Misa, se invita a los fieles a continuar la Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento durante toda la noche, al igual que se invitó a los discípulos a permanecer despiertos con el Señor durante Su agonía en el jardín antes de Su traición por Judas.

Después del Jueves Santo, no se volverá a celebrar Misa en la Iglesia hasta que la Vigilia Pascual celebre y proclame la Resurrección del Señor Jesucristo.

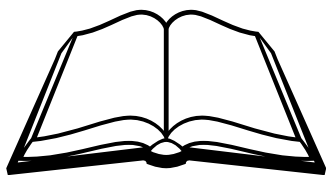
A MEDIDA QUE LA CUARESMA LLEGA A SU FIN...

HOLY THURSDAY is the commemoration of the Last Supper of Jesus Christ, when He established the Sacrament of Holy Communion prior to His arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates His institution of the priesthood. The holy day falls on the Thursday before Easter and is part of Holy Week. Jesus celebrated the dinner as a Passover feast. Christ would fulfill His role as the Christian victim of the Passover for all to be saved by His final sacrifice. The Last Supper was the final meal Jesus shared with His disciples in Jerusalem. During the meal, Jesus predicts His betrayal.

This establishment of the priesthood is reenacted at Mass with the priest washing the feet of several parishioners. On the night of Holy Thursday, Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place where the faithful remain in the presence of the Eucharist just as the disciples kept a vigil with Christ.

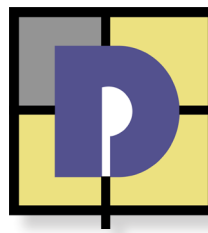
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
