

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
FONTANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND
FONTANA TEACHERS ASSOCIATION**

**Temporary Assignment of Sixth (6th) Grade Teachers at Oak Grove Preparatory Academy
and Transition to the New Elementary School**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into by and between the Fontana Unified School District (“District”) and Fontana Teachers Association (“Association”) for the purpose of clarifying the terms and conditions of employment for certificated teachers assigned to teach sixth (6th) grade at Oak Grove Preparatory Academy (“Academy”), and their subsequent transition to the new Elementary School.

1. Temporary Assignment at the Academy

- 1.1 Pending the completion and opening of the new Elementary School, teachers placed into designated sixth (6th) grade positions for the new Academy shall be temporarily housed and assigned at the Academy and will follow the Academy’s bell schedule.

2. Planned Reassignment to the New Elementary School

- 2.1 Upon the opening of the new Elementary School, teachers assigned under this MOU shall be reassigned to that school and follow the site’s bell schedule.
- 2.2 This MOU does not grant any rights to a specific grade-level assignment.
- 2.3 Grade-level assignments at the new Elementary School shall be made in accordance with enrollment and educational program needs.
- 2.4 Prior to the opening of the new Elementary School, teachers will have the option of two (2) days of release time or fourteen (14) hours of paid time outside of their contractual workday, at the teacher hourly rate, to transition from the Academy to the new Elementary School.

3. Term of Agreement

- 3.1 This MOU is effective March 12, 2026, and remains in effect through the completion of the transition of sixth (6th) grade teachers to the new Elementary School or is superseded by mutual written agreement between District and Association.
