

As we strive to better serve our parish community, I am writing to share an important update regarding our Mass schedule starting August 1, 2025, Over the past years since COVID, Mass times had been more irregular than normal. After careful consideration of attendance patterns, clergy availability, and our shared desire for a more streamlined and consistent experience, we will be adjusting our Mass and Confession times.

Monday through Friday: 8:00 AM Saturday: 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM (Vigil Mass) Sunday: 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 12:00 PM

Additionally, Confessions will be offered at 3:00PM on Friday and after the 8:00 AM mass on Saturday to provide a more consistent and accessible opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

I know that change is never easy, and it may take some time to adjust to this new schedule. Please know that this decision was not made lightly but with the well-being of our parish community in mind.

As we move forward with this new schedule, let us continue to support one another and grow together as a parish family. Thank you for your dedication, your prayers, and your trust. May God bless you and your loved ones abundantly.




