RECIPE OF THE MONTH...

Baked Strawberries and Cream French Toast

INGREDIENTS:

1 (16-ounce) loaf brioche bread, cubed	1/3 cup maple syrup
1 (8-ounce) package cream cheese, cubed	1 tsp vanilla extract
1 pound strawberries, diced and divided	1/2 tsp kosher salt
12 large eggs, beaten	1 tbl confectioners' sugar
2 cups whole milk	

DIRECTIONS:

Lightly coat a 9x13 baking dish with nonstick spray. Place a layer of bread cubes evenly into the baking dish. Top with cream cheese and half the strawberries in an even layer. Top with remaining bread cubes to completely cover the filling.

In a large glass measuring cup or another bowl, whisk together eggs, milk, maple syrup, vanilla and salt. Pour mixture evenly over the bread cubes. Cover and place in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours or overnight.

Preheat oven to 350°. Remove baking dish from the refrigerator; let stand 30 minutes.

Bake, covered, for 30 minutes. Uncover; continue to bake for an additional 25-30 minutes, or until golden brown and center is firm. Serve immediately, sprinkle with remaining strawberries and confectioners sugar.
