As the crisp fall weather settles in, it's the perfect time to give your tires a little extra attention. With cooler temperatures, shorter days, and unpredictable Wisconsin weather, your tires play a critical role in keeping you safe on the road

Here are some key fall tire maintenance tips:

1. Check Your Tire Pressure

Cold air causes tire pressure to dropsometimes by 1 PSI for every 10-degree temperature change. Underinflated tires can reduce fuel efficiency, cause uneven wear, and compromise your safety. Be sure to check and adjust your tire pressure regularly this season.

2. Inspect Tread Depth

Adequate tread is essential for traction on wet, fallen leaves and the first frosty mornings. Worn tires can increase stopping distance and reduce control. Here's a quick guide to tread depth replacement recommendations:

- 4/32" or deeper Safe for fall driving.
- 3/32" Time to start planning for replacement soon.
- 2/32" or less Tire replacement is required. At this depth, tires can no longer provide safe traction, especially on wet or slippery roads.

If your tread is getting low, replacing your tires before winter arrives ensures you'll be prepared for snow and ice.

3. Look for Uneven Wear

Uneven tread wear can signal misalignment, suspension issues, or improper inflation. Catching this early can save you from premature tire replacement and keep your vehicle driving smoothly.

4. Rotate Your Tires

Regular tire rotations (every 5,000-6,000 miles) help your tires wear evenly, extending their lifespan. Fall is a great time to schedule one as part of your seasonal maintenance.

5. Schedule a Wheel Alignment

Potholes, curbs, and everyday driving can knock your wheels out of alignment. If your car pulls to one side, your steering wheel isn't centered, or your tires show uneven wear, an alignment check is overdue. Proper alignment helps:

- Extend tire life
- Improve fuel efficiency
- Provide a smoother, safer ride

6. Consider Winter Tires

If you drive frequently in snow or icy conditions, switching to winter tires before the first snowfall provides maximum safety and traction.
