- ✓ Engine Oil Typically brown or black, oil leaks can come from gaskets, seals, or the oil pan. Left unchecked, it can lead to engine damage.
- ✓ Coolant/Antifreeze Often green, orange, or pink, coolant leaks can come from the radiator, water pump, or hoses. Loss of coolant can cause engine overheating.
- Transmission Fluid Usually red or reddishbrown, this slippery fluid helps keep your transmission running smoothly. Leaks can be costly if not addressed.
- **V** Brake Fluid Light yellow to brown, brake fluid leaks are a serious safety concern. If your brake pedal feels soft, get it checked immediately.
- **V** Power Steering Fluid Similar in color to transmission fluid, a leak can cause difficulty steering.
- Windshield Washer Fluid Often bright blue, this one's not dangerous, but it's good to know you have washer fluid when you need it!.
- Fuel Leaks Whether it's gasoline or diesel, you'll usually smell this one before you see it. Fuel leaks are dangerous and should be addressed immediately.

INGREDIENTS:	1 tablespoon unsalted butter					
3 ounces cream cheese	48 cocktail hot dogs					
1/2 cup mayonnaise	1/4 cup hot pepper sauce, plus					
1/4 cup crumbled strong blue	extra for drizzling, such as Frank's	-				
cheese, such as Maytag blue	24 slider potato rolls					
2 ribs celery, finely chopped (about 1 cup), plus extra ribs cut into sticks for serving	1/4 cup finely chopped red onion 1 cup blue potato chips, crushed					


DIRECTIONS:

Combine the cream cheese, mayonnaise and blue cheese in a small saucepan. Cook over medium heat until smooth, stirring frequently, about 3 minutes. Set aside to cool slightly, about 5 minutes, and then stir in the celery.

Heat the butter in a large skillet over medium heat until melted. Add the hot dogs and cook until heated through, stirring occasionally, 5 minutes. Stir in the hot sauce and cook until the hot dogs are coated, 1 to 2 minutes. Slice vertically through each potato bun, about halfway through so it resembles a top-split hot dog bun, and place 2 buffalo dogs in each. Top with 1 to 2 teaspoons of the blue cheese sauce, a drizzle of hot sauce (as spicy as you like it), some red onions and crushed blue chips.

Serve the sliders with any extra blue cheese sauce and celery sticks on the side for dipping.
