



2026 Holiday Schedule for Garbage Pick up

If a holiday falls on a weekend, it will not affect service schedules.

Christmas Day	Collection delayed 1 day
New Years Eve	Normal collection schedule
New Years Day	Collection delayed 1 day
Day after New Years Day	Normal collection schedule
Thanksgiving Day	Collection delayed 1 day
Independence Day	Collection delayed 1 day
Labor Day	Collection delayed 1 day
Martin Luther King Day	Normal collection schedule
Memorial Day	Collection delayed 1 day
Veterans Day	Normal collection schedule

Helpful Garbage Pickup Tips!

- Regular pick up is on Wednesday morning. Cans should be out for service the night before pick-up, service times change, this is the best way to guarantee your can will be serviced. Bring cans back in after service!
- Bag all trash to help prevent items from blowing out of the can and/or sticking to the inside of container. Spilt garbage is the can owner's responsibility to clean up.
- Cans should never be on the street! Cans should be off the side of the street but no more than 3ft from the street. Leave 3-4ft between cans. Ignoring this rule may result in your can being skipped.
- An overfilled can may be skipped! If you need an additional can please call the city office, it is only an extra \$10 per month to have an extra can!
- If your can is accidentally damaged and you need a new one, please call the city office and we will replace your can for free. If you have burned the can or intentionally damaged it you will be charged to replace the can.
- In winter months shovel a spot for your can off the side of the street. Cans should never be on the street; this makes garbage pick-up difficult/impossible and prevents the plow from properly clearing snow from the streets.
