- Yes! St. Luke's Church offers Eucharistic Adoration **most Mondays** during the year, except for those Mondays that fall on a federal holiday.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION - MONDAYS



7:00 a.m.	Mass (prayer intentions recorded in the intercessory prayer book, which is in the main lobby, then moved to the altar prior to Mass, and left during Adoration as a reminder to pray for those intentions)
7:30 a.m.	Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and the Rosary
4:00 p.m.	Prayer for the Intention of the Holy Father, Prayers of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Memorare, Litany of Loreto, Evening Prayer
5:45 p.m.	Benediction and Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION IS HELD EVERY MONDAY, EXCEPT ON FEDERAL HOLIDAYS

- **Come anytime**, for as long as you like - **no obligation!** If you are on your way home from work or school and pressed for time, just 10 to 15 minutes with Jesus is a great way to take timeout from your busy day, and give thanks and praise to He who set us free from our sins.
- Hopefully, you can stay longer! If so please, **consider signing up for an hour on a regular basis.** Our goal is two (2) "adorers" present before the Blessed Sacrament at all times.
