

This weekend we will have Anointing of the Sick at the 4:00 pm Vigil Mass at St. Hedwig and the 10:30 am Mass at St. Patrick.

The third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday. The word "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice." Gaudete Sunday reminds us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent. We light the pink or rose colored candle.

Saint John of the Cross tells us that "Joy is not the absence of suffering but the presence of God." It is the presence of God that brings us joy, even in hard times. And joy, Chesterton notes, "is the gigantic secret of the Christian." Joy comes from God.

O What is the "St. Patrick & St. Hedwig Remembrance?

The St. Patrick & St. Hedwig Remembrance Intentions is a special offering made by parishioners of St. Patrick & St. Hedwig, through which your intentions are remembered at a special Mass to be celebrated each month throughout the entire year.

Why start such a Remembrance?

What is the requested Offering?

We will begin the Masses in January. The "intention year" will then be from January to January. And then we begin again. If you wish to continue having your intentions remembered at these Masses, you will be asked to renew your offering each year.
