From the Desk of Fr. Eric Zimmer....

Dear Parishioners,

This coming week I will meet with the parish finance councils and parish pastoral councils of each parish. Going forward, the parish councils will meet the first week of the month, with Tuesday assigned to St. Patrick and Wednesday assigned to St. Hedwig. The parish finance councils will meet in the first week of each quarter (January, April, July, and October), with the exception of meeting this coming week for the first quarter. If you have any concerns or questions for either group, please feel free to contact these members. Their names are below.

I want to let you know of a few updates to the church properties. As you enter the churches this weekend you will see that a number of trees have been taken down around both buildings. You may also have noticed that we have been working on getting the light timers set up correctly for the statues, the grotto at Saint Hedwig, and the façade of both churches. A recent inspection of the grounds found missing slate tiles on St. Patrick Church. We hope to be able to get these tiles replaced for the proper maintenance of the building and for the safety of those walking below. We have taken these measures to avoid longer-term problems and the threats to the structures.

I am also currently exploring landscaping possibilities to enhance the "curb appeal" of our campus with a professional design for each church. We have two beautiful houses of worship and I am confident that with new plantings they will be properly framed.

Please feel free to contact the office if you notice any needs for maintenance at either church.
