Marcus Construction is a family-owned business founded in 1956. As a complete general contractor, the company designs and builds solutions for dry fertilizer storage, warehouses for chemical, seed, liquid fertilizer, bulk and packaged products, single product dome and arch storage, office and training centers, and complex renovation projects. Through its design and pre-construction services, Marcus Construction serves as a single point of contact from concept to completion, providing high-quality, turn-key site and building solutions for clients nationwide across the agribusiness, commercial, industrial, and public works sectors.

Founded by Carl Marcus, the company began with agricultural wood buildings before expanding into pre-engineered metal buildings in the 1970s. The 1990s marked significant growth in agribusiness with dry fertilizer storage and chemical warehouses. Strategic acquisitions followed, including a commercial wood framing business in 2020 and a specialized bulk dome storage company in 2023, which aligned with Marcus Construction's agricultural storage portfolio while opening opportunities in the public works sector for salt and sand storage.

As Marcus Construction celebrated 70 years in business, the company also marked a strategic leadership transition. As of January 1, 2026, Ross Marcus transitioned from CEO to President, Taylor Marcus stepped into the role of CEO, and Darin Bushard transitioned to Vice President of Business Development.

At Marcus Construction, the mission extends beyond building exceptional facilities, the company is committed to building stronger communities. Guided by its FORGE core values, Marcus Construction is dedicated to service, integrity, and stewardship while investing in initiatives focused on faith-based organizations, client-led initiatives, youth and education, agriculture and agribusiness support, and veteran and first responder support.
