How to Purchase a Havana Bucks Digital Gift Card

1. Go to Yiftee's website

Visit the Yiftee portal for your community's gift card

https://app.yiftee.com/gift-card/havana-main-street--fl OR



2. Choose a gift card amount

Select from preset amounts (e.g. \$25, \$50, etc.) or enter a custom value if that's allowed.

3. Pay the e-Delivery fee

Yiftee assesses a small processing fee for sending a digital gift card (typically \$1 plus 5% of the gift card value).

4. Send to the recipient

You can send the e-gift card directly to yourself or someone else via email or text.

- If giving it to yourself, treat it like a digital voucher for future use.
- If giving to another, they'll receive an email/text with instructions and a link.

5. Check email / spam folder for the voucher

Sometimes Yiftee's delivery email may land in spam — so check all folders.

How to Use / Redeem Havana Bucks (via Yiftee)

Once you (or your recipient) have the digital voucher, here's how to redeem it:

1. Activate the voucher

Use the link provided in the email/text. The voucher must be activated before spending.

- 2. Choose how to present the voucher at checkout you have three main options:
 - Tap-to-Pay: Add the card to your mobile wallet (Apple Wallet or Google Pay), then tap at the payment terminal if the merchant accepts contactless payments.
 - Print Voucher: Print the digital voucher and bring the paper copy to the store.
 - Use via Yiftee App: For Apple users: download the Yiftee mobile app (if you haven't already), log in with the email that received the voucher your card will appear under "My Gifts." Show it at checkout or use Tap-to-Pay if supported.

 For Android users: log-in to Yiftee.com and create an account. You will need to enter your name, email and create a password. Once you are logged in on your dashboard you will be able to track gifts you've sent, cards in your wallet and balances available on each card.

3. Merchant Redeems It Like a Payment Card

At the register, the merchant enters the 16-digit card number, expiration date, and CVV into their POS (point-of-sale) system as if processing a Mastercard-type payment.

The card cannot be swiped — manual entry or tap-to-pay only.

4. Be prepared for "split-payment" if needed

If your purchase exceeds the available balance on the card, you'll need to pay the difference using another payment method.

5. Check your balance

You or the cardholder can check the remaining balance at any time by entering the card number on Yiftee's "Check Gift Balance" page.

6. Refunds are allowed

If a merchant issues a refund for a purchase made with the card, the funds can be returned to the same Yiftee card — just like with a regular credit card refund.
