PUBLIC WORKS COMPLEX DEDICATION CEREMONY



The City of Farmington held a ceremony in March to dedicate the Larry D. Forsythe Public Works Complex. Located at 214 Industrial Drive, the complex serves as the central facility for the City's Electric, Street, Water and Sewer Departments. A newly added building will provide expanded office space and additional storage to better support the Water and Sewer Department and improve efficiency.

The complex is named in honor of former Farmington Mayor Larry Forsythe, whose leadership and vision helped guide the expansion project.

Did you know? Blowing grass clippings and leaves into Farmington streets violates city ordinance.

Farmington officials are reminding residents to keep grass clippings and yard debris out of roadways when mowing.

Leaves and grass left in the street can wash into storm drains and streams, adding nutrients that contribute to harmful algal blooms.

Debris can also clog storm drains, increasing the risk of localized flooding.

Residents are encouraged to blow or sweep clippings back onto their property or bag them. Yard waste can also be taken to the city's disposal site at 3875 Pimville Road. The site is for use by those who reside inside the city limits of Farmington only and no commercial disposal is permitted.

Utilities

Farmington City Light & Water recently resumed regular service disconnections for non-payment. Disconnections had been delayed due to below 32°F temperatures, in accordance with the Missouri Cold Weather Rule, as well as recent changes to billing software. Customers who miss a monthly payment receive a notice and are given ten days to pay before service is disconnected.

To restore service, customers must pay their balance or enter into a payment agreement. If needed, financial assistance may be available through East Missouri Action Agency. To apply, call 573.431.5191 or visit eastmoaa.org.

To help manage future bills, eligible customers may enroll in Budget Billing, which offers consistent monthly payments based on average usage. Please contact our office for details.
