## **RULES AND REGULATIONS-FARMINGTON WATER PARK**

Make the most of your visit to the Farmington Water Park by planning ahead! Before arriving, be sure to review our daily hours, weather-related updates, and the rules and regulations that may affect your visit. A little preparation goes a long way toward creating a fun, stress-free experience at the Water Park!

1. Everyone entering the Water Park must be season pass holder or pay the daily fee. A hand stamp or receipt is required for re-entry.
2. All guests shall behave in a manner to avoid jeopardizing the health and safety of themselves or others. Disruptive behavior, including abusive or profane language is ground for expulsion without a refund.
3. Children four (4) years of age and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian sixteen (16) or older in the water and must be at least an arm's length away.
4. Children 5 to 11 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 16 or older.
5. Guests who have, or are suspected of having, any contagious or infectious illness—including diarrhea—are not permitted to enter or use the water park facilities. For the health and safety of all patrons, individuals must be free of symptoms for at least 24 hours before participating in aquatic activities.
6. Anyone who has an area of sub-epidermal tissue (deep cut that breaks the skin), open blisters or wounds, etc., is advised not to enter the pool.
7. A person under the influence of drugs or alcohol or exhibiting erratic shall not be permitted into the pool.
8. Appropriate swim attire is required in order to enter any of the pools in the water park. No cut offs, jean shorts, thongs, or inappropriately exposed skin. All attire is subject to staff and management review and discretion.
9. Inappropriate body markings, including certain tattoos, may be required to be covered and are subject to review at the discretion of staff and management.
10. Air inflated devices are prohibited. (This includes water wings.) Only US Coast Guard approved life vests are allowed in the water park. A limited number of life vests are available in the Water Park and can be used at no charge. Guards can check for proper fit.

11. No coolers or outside food or beverages are permitted inside the water park, with the exception of a sealed water bottle and/or an **empty** tumbler. Glass items and gum are not allowed. If you or your child has a medical-related need, please contact management prior to your visit for accommodation.
12. The Farmington Water Park is drug, alcohol and tobacco free. This includes vapes and e-cigarettes. Tobacco may be used 25 feet outside the perimeter of the park.
13. Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. They are advised for those 3 years and younger. If a swim diaper is needed, please inquire at admissions.
14. Horseplay and running on the pool deck are not permitted.
15. Breast feeding area is available in the air-conditioned first aid room.
16. The water park is open daily during our regular season. The park may close due to severe weather, unsuitable outdoor temperatures, or unexpected maintenance needs, low attendance in the park (under 20 guests) or due to unforeseen circumstances at any time.
17. Rain checks will be issued when the pool has been cleared for any reason and remains closed for at least one hour. Rain checks may be used for admission on another day during the current season. The park will remain open until the Parks and Recreation Director determines that the facility should close for the day. Guests must present their receipt to receive a rain check. No cash refunds will be provided, and rain checks will not be issued after 4:00 PM.
18. The Water Park may limit entry when the facility approaches capacity. New guests may be required to wait until other patrons exit before being admitted. This policy is in place to ensure the safety and comfort of all guests. Anyone who has already been admitted to the park may leave and re-enter as needed.
19. Pool management has the authority to implement and enforce rules not listed that are more stringent to supplement those listed for the safety of our guests. The City also retains the right to include additional rules and regulations, without notice, to ensure the health and safety of all guests.
