Job Title: Street & Maintenance Worker

Direct Supervisor Title: Street Superintendent

Job Summary:

Works under the direction of the Street & Maintenance Supervisor, and performs construction and maintenance work on City streets, alleys, parks, and the storm drain system as part of a crew. Also works as a crew member on construction repair of City facilities as required.

General Duties/Responsibilities:

The following duties are standard for this job. These are not construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Operates City heavy maintenance equipment such as Dump Trucks, Loader, Street Grader, Backhoe, Street Sweeper and Leaf Vacuum.
- Works as laborer on City streets, alleys and snow removal.
- Works on construction projects as catch basin and manhole construction.
- Works in shop doing maintenance on equipment.
- Works in City parks mowing lawns, weed eating, cleaning bathrooms, trimming trees, and maintaining equipment.

The above list of essential functions is not exhaustive and may be supplemented as necessary by the City.

Desirable Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:
