No Lobbying or Electioneering

LOR Foundation grant funds may not be used by your organization to intervene in any election or support or oppose any political party or candidate for public office, or to carry on propaganda, or otherwise to attempt to influence any legislation, within the meaning of Section 4945 of Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and the Treasury Regulations.

Return of Unused Funds

Any grant funds not expended in furtherance of the Grant Project will be returned to the LOR Foundation. Grantee accepts full control of the grant and its disposition. In the event your organization breaches the terms of this grant agreement, Grantee shall be required to reimburse the LOR Foundation for all funds furnished hereunder and shall be liable to the LOR Foundation for any and all damages suffered as a result of such breach. Grantee agrees to maintain adequate financial and programmatic records and to retain those records for at least four years after the conclusion of the Grant Project.

Evaluation and Monitoring

The LOR Foundation may monitor, evaluate, and audit the results and operations under this grant, which may include a visit from the LOR Foundation and its representatives to observe your organization's Grant Project, discuss the Grant Project with your organization's personnel, and review financial and other records and materials connected with the activities financed by this grant. Grantee agrees to promptly provide such additional information, reports, and documents as the LOR Foundation and its representatives may request.

Work Product

Grantee and the LOR Foundation agree that all copyright and other interests in data, processes, and materials produced or developed by Grantee as a result of this grant shall be owned by Grantee, but that Grantee shall grant, and shall cause any individuals who may have some interest to grant, and hereby does grant to the LOR Foundation a non-exclusive, transferable, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, paid-up, worldwide license to use or publish, create derivative works, and to sublicense the data, processes, materials or other work products arising out of or resulting from Grantee's use of the grant funds, including all intellectual property rights. For the avoidance of doubt, the foregoing assignment of rights does not apply to open source materials, or any other materials that are owned by and licensed from a third party, or the proprietary information and practices of the grantee.

Tax Status

Grantee warrants and represents that it is a government unit eligible to receive grants from a private foundation.

Grantee agrees immediately to notify the LOR Foundation, in writing, if: the Grantee's eligibility to receive grants of this nature changes in any way; Grantee has reasonable grounds to believe that its eligibility may be revoked or altered; or, Grantee has reason to believe that these grant monies cannot be or continue to be expended for the specific purposes of the Grant Project. In the event that Grantee becomes ineligible to receive or manage grant funds

before all funds under this grant are dispensed, this grant agreement will be considered null and void and all obligations of the LOR Foundation hereunder will terminate.

Compliance

Grantee warrants that it is in full compliance with its grant agreement with the LOR Foundation and that if the grant was subject to any conditions or restrictions, all such conditions or restrictions were observed.

Insurance and Liability

Grantee agrees to maintain such insurance as will fully protect both Grantee and the LOR Foundation from any or all claims under any workers' compensation act or employer's liability laws, and from any and all claims of whatsoever kind or nature for the damage to property or for bodily injury, including death, made by anyone, which may arise from operations carried on under this grant agreement, either by the Grantee or by anyone directly or indirectly engaged or employed by the Grantee. Grantee agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the LOR Foundation from any liability, loss, cost, expense, injury, damage, or other expense that may be incurred by the LOR Foundation or claimed by any third person against the LOR Foundation as a result of the LOR Foundation's funding of the project or any action or non-action taken in connection with the grant, or any asset submitted to the LOR Foundation by Grantee, including any claim of intellectual property infringement or violation of the right of publicity.
