WEISER CITY ORDINANCE NO. 1279

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEISER, WASHINGTON COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 8, PUBLIC WAYS AND PROPERTY, WEISER CITY CODE, CHAPTER 7, PUBLIC PARKS, SECTION 8-7-6; PARK OPERATING POLICY; PROVIDING FOR PARK RESERVATIONS AND PARK RESERVATION FEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL, AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEISER, IDAHO, THAT WEISER CITY CODE TITLE 8, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 8-7-6, BE AMENDED TO READ IN ITS ENTIRETY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Title 8, Chapter 7, Section 8-7-6, Weiser City Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“8-7-6: PARK OPERATING POLICY:

A. Park Hours: Except for unusual and unforeseen emergencies, parks shall be open to the public every day of the year from six o'clock (6:00) A.M. to twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight. Thereafter, visitors and vehicles shall be excluded during the hours of closure except for transit through a park. The mayor shall have the authority to change the hours of any park by proclamation and the publication of the proclamation in the "Weiser Signal American", the official newspaper of the city.

B. Closed Areas: Any section or part of any park may be declared closed to the public by the Weiser city council or duly authorized representative at any time and for any interval of time, either temporarily or at regularly and stated intervals (daily or otherwise) and either entirely or merely to certain uses, as the city council or duly authorized representative shall find reasonably necessary.

C. Park Reservations: Use of park facilities is on a first come, first served basis unless reserved pursuant to city policy. Reservations may be made by any party for any covered area in any park facility, including but not limited to picnic shelters. All persons requesting advance reservation shall pay a fee as provided by resolution and approved by City Clerk or designated representative and shall observe all City regulations and requirements. Such areas designated as "reserved" shall remain reserved for the exclusive use of the reservation holder during their reservation period.

If persons using a facility have not reserved the time and paid the appropriate fee, and are using the facility at a time that has been reserved for another person, they shall be required to vacate the facility. If they refuse to vacate the facility, they may be excluded from the park pursuant to the authority granted in this chapter.

A list of reservations for a particular facility shall be maintained by the City Clerk to inform the public who has reserved the facility and the time, or times, for which the facility has been reserved.

It is prohibited for any person to fail or refuse to comply with directions given City staff in regulating the activities in any area when necessary to prevent congestion and to secure the maximum use for the comfort and convenience of all. Failure to observe such City rules and regulations shall result in the immediate termination of the advance reservation. It is prohibited for any person to remove tables from reserved areas.

It shall be the duty of the reservation holder to leave all facilities reserved for use in a condition identical to that when those facilities were permitted to the reservation holder for use. It is prohibited for any person to leave a picnic area before the fire is completely extinguished and before all trash in the nature of boxes, papers, cans, garbage and other refuse is placed in disposal receptacles where provided. If no such trash receptacles are available, then refuse and trash shall be carried away from the park area by the picnicker to be properly disposed of elsewhere.”

SECTION 2: All previous ordinances, resolutions, order, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, rescinded and annulled.

SECTION 3: If any part of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or void, such part shall be deemed severable, and its invalidity shall not affect the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: The City Clerk is instructed to immediately forward this ordinance to the codifier of the official municipal code for proper revision of the code.

SECTION 5: This ordinance, or a summary thereof in compliance with Section 50-901A, Idaho Code, shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in force upon its passage, approval, and publication.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEISER, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, IMPLEMENTING FEES CHARGED BY THE CITY OF WEISER FOR RESERVED USAGE OF CITY PARK FACILITIES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City owns various park facilities; and,

WHEREAS, Weiser City Code 8-7-6- authorizes the City Council to adopt and modify fees for persons requesting advance reservations of City park facilities.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is appropriate, necessary, reasonable, and in the best interest of the City to collect fees for advance reservations of City park facilities by third parties; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such fees shown on the fee schedule, set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are reasonably based upon the fixed administrative costs of advance park reservations; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public hearing conducted on the matter of such fees was conducted pursuant to proper notice and the requirements of Idaho law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEISER, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the new established fees in the fee schedule set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are approved.
2. That the Mayor and City Council are hereby authorized to execute said schedule for and on behalf of the City of Weiser.
3. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
