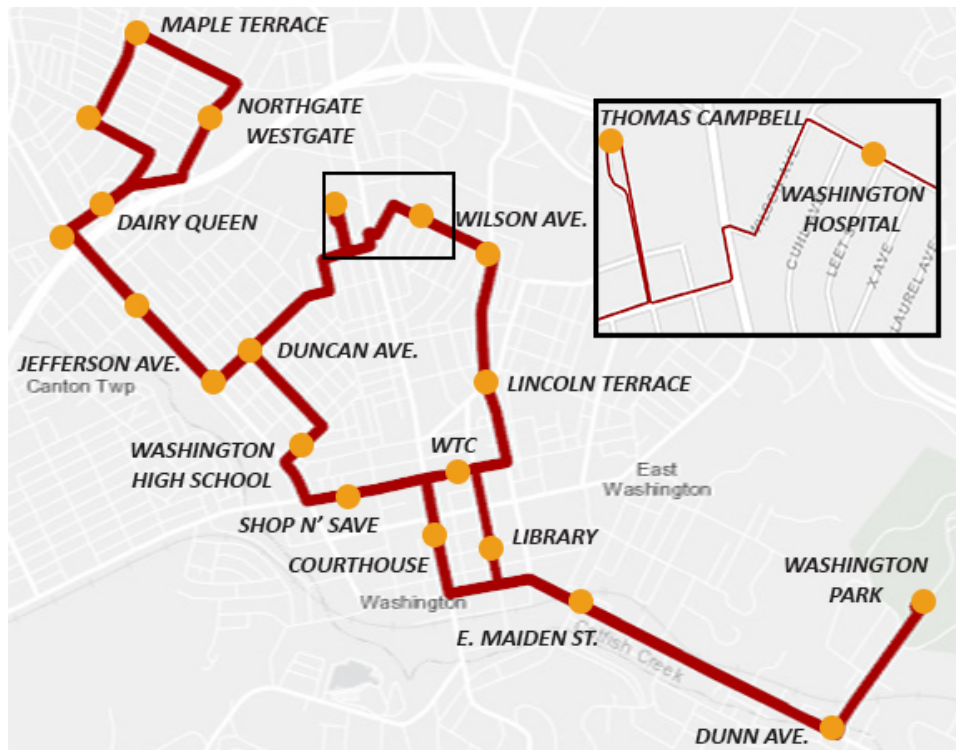




Freedom Transit operates fixed route bus service in and around the Washington area, Monday through Saturday.

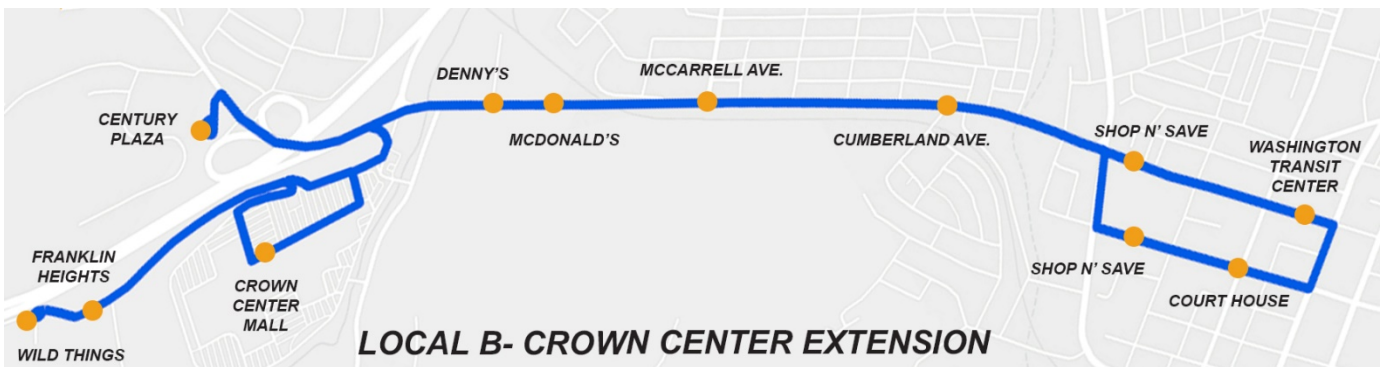
### WASHINGTON LOCAL ROUTES:

- Local A- You can use this route to get to Washington Park (home of Lew Hays PONY Field). This route will also take you to Washington Transit Center and Downtown Washington. Monday through Friday from 6:50 AM to 7:05 PM.



- Local B- This route will take you to many shopping & entertainment options in and around Washington. Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 7:05 PM. Some stops of interest along this route include:
  - Pony Baseball & Softball Headquarters

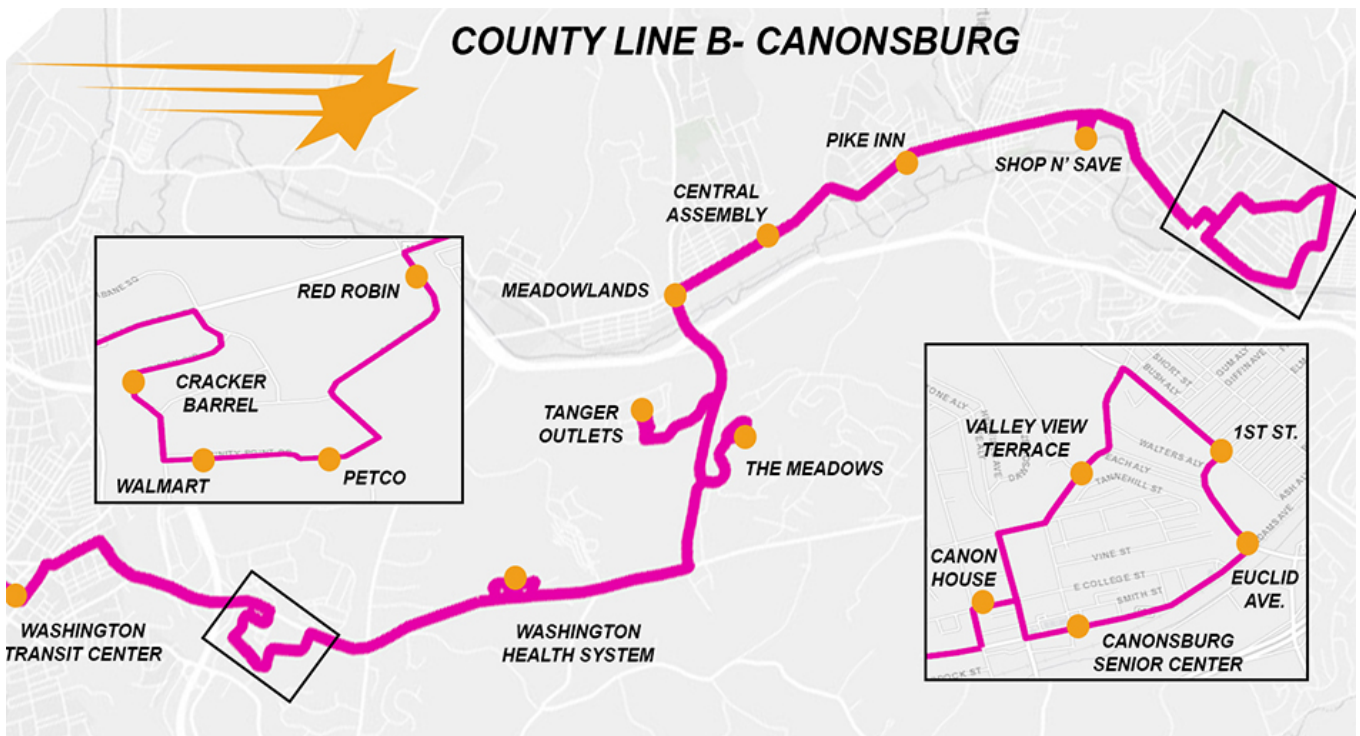
- Crown Center Mall
- Trinity Point (Walmart, restaurants)
- The Old Mill Shopping Center (Hobby Lobby, Buffalo Wild Wings, restaurants)
- Strabane Square (Giant Eagle, Target)
- Washington Transit Center

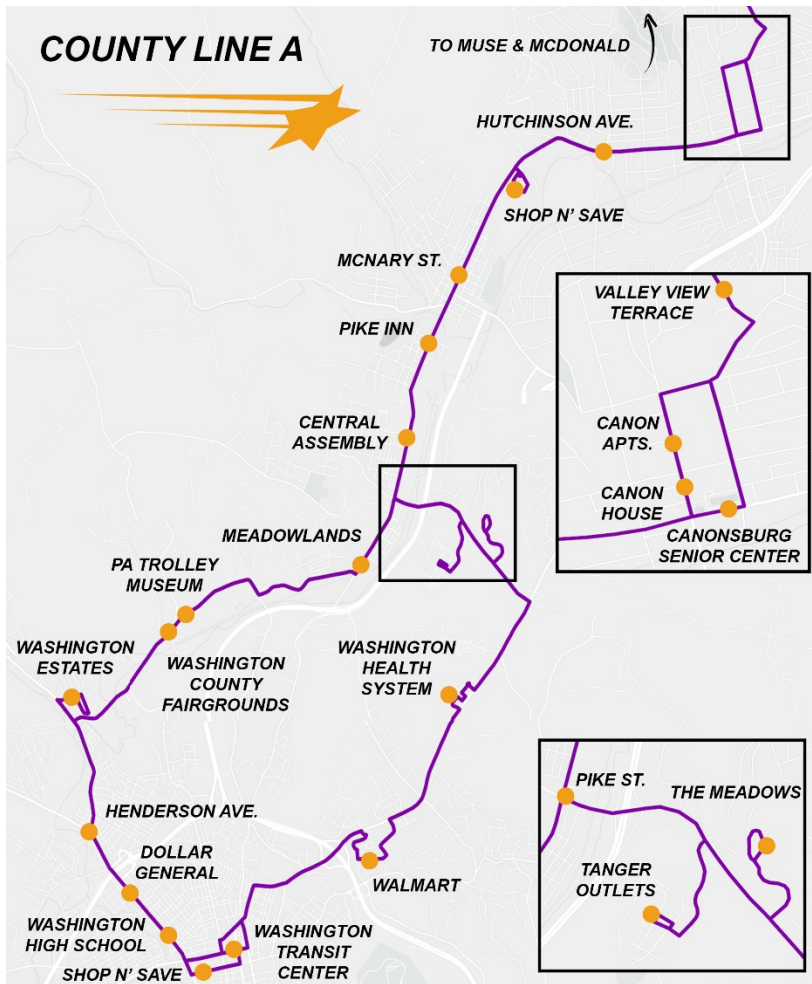


- Local Saturday- The Local Saturday route combines all of the stops along the weekday Local A & Local B routes. Saturday, 8:30 AM to 6:30 PM. Please refer to the routes listed above for information on the stops along the Local Saturday.

**RACETRACK ROAD (THE MEADOWS & TANGER OUTLETS) ROUTE:**

- County Line A & B- Both County Line routes service the areas of Washington, Canonsburg, and other surrounding locations with stops at Racetrack Road locations including The Meadows Racetrack & Casino and Tanger Outlets. Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM to 6:05 PM. Some stops of interest along the County Line routes include:
  - The Meadows Racetrack & Casino
  - Tanger Outlets
  - Microtel Inn (Racetrack Road)
  - Cambria Hotel (Racetrack Road)
  - Courtyard by Marriot (Tanger Blvd.)
  - Hyatt Place Pittsburgh (Meadows Dr.)
  - The Street shopping & dining (Adios Dr.- Primanti Brothers)
  - Washington Transit Center





## DOWNTOWN PITTSBURGH ROUTE:

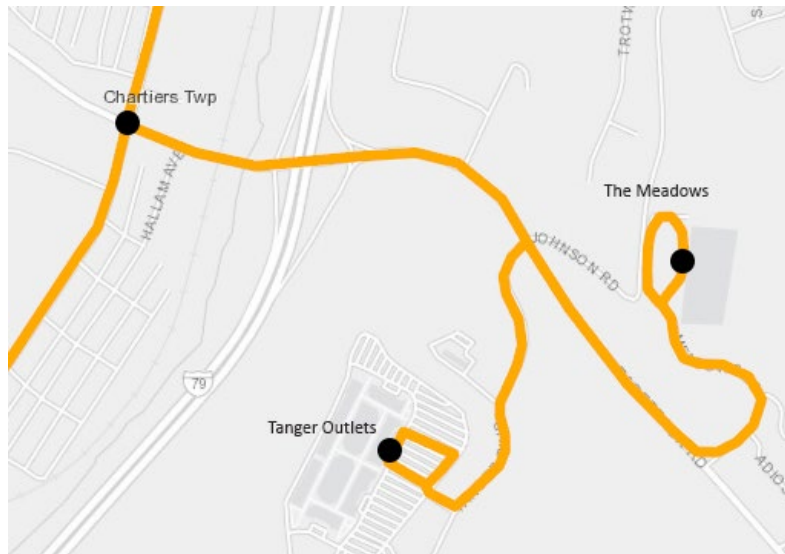
- Pittsburgh Metro- The Pittsburgh Metro runs from Washington into Downtown Pittsburgh with four stops in the city. Monday through Friday from 5:00 AM to 7:45 PM. Stops in Downtown Pittsburgh include:
  - Gateway Center (Access to the Pittsburgh “T”. One block from PPG Place & Market Square. Within walking distance of The Point & Northshore locations).
  - Point Park University (Within walking distance of PPG Place & Market Square).
  - 5<sup>th</sup> & Smithfield St. (Heart of Downtown Pittsburgh with access to shopping, dining, and entertainment locations).
  - East Busway (Access to convention center, Heinz History Center, and Strip District).

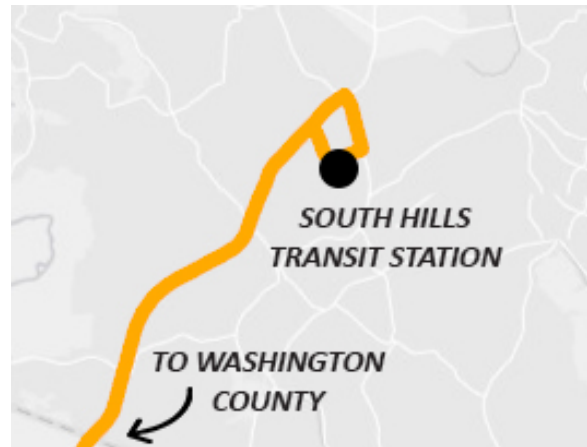
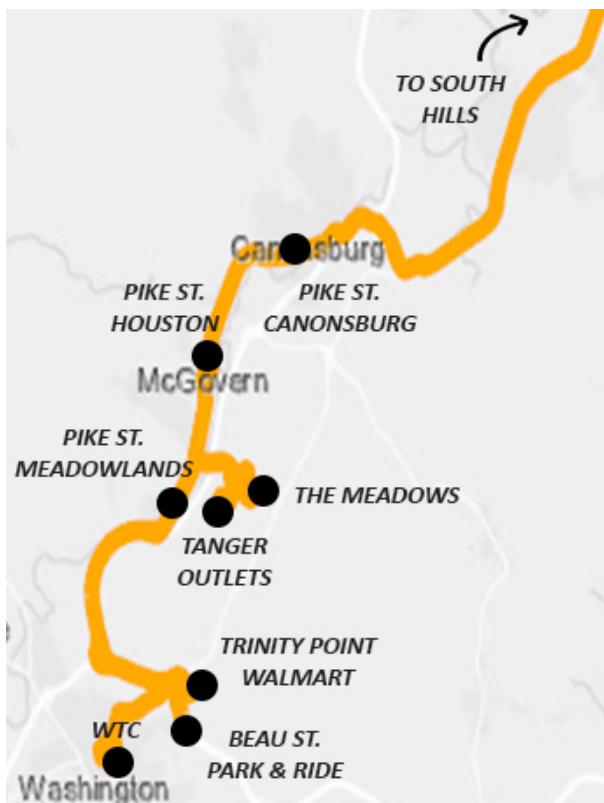

**SATURDAY RACETRACK ROAD ROUTE:**

- Saturday Metro- The Saturday Metro provides service to Racetrack Road locations including The Meadows Racetrack & Casino and Tanger Outlets. The route then continues to South Hills Village “T” Station where you can transfer to the “T” to access Downtown Pittsburgh. Saturday from 9:15 AM to 5:45 PM.





**BUS FARES:** The fare system for the bus operates as “zones”.

- Zone 1: Washington, Racetrack Road locations
- Zone 2: Canonsburg and the rest of Washington County
- Zone 3: Downtown Pittsburgh

Riding within a single zone: \$1.50

Zones 1-2 \$2.50

Zones 2-3 \$3.50

Zones 1-3 \$5.00

**Children 11 and under ride FREE with an accompanying adult.**

Transfers are free when transferring to a bus within the same zone.

When transferring to a bus in a different zone, simply pay the “up value” as you board the vehicle. Need a transfer? Ask the driver on the first bus you ride to issue you a transfer slip as you depart the vehicle and hand this slip to the driver of the second bus you board.

Freedom Transit bus routes operate as a Flag Stop, where you are able to “flag” down the bus anywhere along the set route, as long as it is in a safe location for the driver to pull over. Make sure you are standing

along the correct side of the road in which direction you would like to travel and simply wave your arm as the driver approaches to “flag” them down.
