


# The Austin Relocation Guide

## THE MOVE

The more you plan the logistics of your move in advance, the more seamless the experience! Here is a sample timeline of things to consider and when to tackle them.

### 12+ Weeks Before

- Interview moving companies & obtain quotes
- Reserve a storage unit or moving truck if needed
- Continue visiting neighborhoods
- Put your current home on the market, if applicable

### 6 Weeks Before

- Schedule movers
- Make travel arrangements
- Notify schools of your move
- Keep track of moving expenses for possible tax deductions
- Update your various insurance providers



# THE MOVE

### 4 Weeks Before

- Sell, declutter, donate
- Update memberships (gyms, local clubs, etc.)
- Begin packing
- Secure a new home
- Forward mail to a P.O. box

### 2 Weeks Before

- Transfer Utilities
- Change mailing address (banks, credit cards, etc)
- Order any large furniture & appliances
- Secure parking for the moving truck or POD
- Coordinate time off from work

### 1 Week Before

- Coordinate logistics of your move-in/out date
- Ensure all funds are in place for deposits, closing costs, etc.
- Confirm movers or rental truck



# THE MOVE

### 1 Day Before

- Pack short-term suitcase & essentials
- Do a final sweep and clean

### Moving Day

- Hand over keys
- Pick up keys to your new home!
- Start your journey!

### Post Move

- Possible second cleaning of new house
- Change locks
- Register devices and appliances, if applicable
- Update driver's license and registration
- Pick up new mailbox keys at local post office
