



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Tuesday, April 14, 2026, just after 1pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams responded to a single vehicle accident in Old Kuttawa. His investigation revealed a 2004 Ford, Excursion with a boat trailer in tow and being driven by Jacqueline Toppel (72) of Princeton, was backing down a boat ramp when the driver lost control and the vehicle was submerged in Lake Barkley. No injuries were reported in the accident. The Lyon County Water Response Team, Lyon County EMS, and Emergency Management assisted Chief Deputy Adams at the scene.
- On Wednesday, April 15, 2026, around 8:25am, Sheriff Brent White served a Crittenden Circuit Court bench warrant on Kristy S. Moore (45) of Cadiz for Contempt of Court. She was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Wednesday, April 15, 2026, around 9:25am, Sheriff Brent White served three (3) Union Circuit Court bench warrants on Mark Thornton (53) of Harrisburg, IL. He was charged with felony probation violations in three separate cases. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Wednesday, April 15, 2026, around 10:15am, Sheriff Brent White served a criminal summons on Sarah W. Riley (37) of Marion charging her with Theft by Deception (including cold checks) under \$300. Riley was provided a criminal court date to appear in Crittenden District Court in May.
- On Thursday, April 16, 2026, around 5:25pm, Deputy Josh Travis responded to a single-vehicle collision on I-69 near US 62. His investigation revealed a 2025 Ford, driven by Skyler P. Harris (21) and passenger, Makenna P. Hall (23) both of Owensboro, were South on I-69 during rain conditions when Harris lost control of her vehicle and exited the right shoulder before traveling down an embankment and colliding with a tree. Both occupants sustained minor injuries and were transported by Lyon County EMS, to Lourdes Mercy Health Hospital, to be evaluated and treated. The Eddyville Police Department, Eddyville Fire Department, Kentucky State Police, and Lyon County EMS assisted Deputy Travis at the scene.
- On Friday, April 17, 2026, around 11:20am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served a Union District Court bench warrant on David R. Lawless (47) of Eddyville, charging him with Failure to Appear in Union District Court. He later posted a cash bond and was released from custody.
- On Saturday, April 18, 2026, around 1:28am, Deputy Josh Travis responded to a single-vehicle collision in the 3000 block of KY 1943. His investigation revealed a 2014 Jeep Patriot, driven by Colleen G. Baldwin (55) of Oakland Park, FL, swerved to avoid a deer before losing control, leaving the roadway and colliding with a parked car. Baldwin was transported to Marshall County Hospital for treatment of her injuries. Lyon County EMS and Eddyville Fire Department assisted Deputy Travis at the scene.
- On Saturday, April 18, 2026, around 6:26pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler arrested Angela G. Perez (aka: Angela Mallory) at a residence on KY 903 near Lamasco. She was the subject of a Lyon District Court complaint warrant charging her with Assault-4th Degree (Domestic Violence) Minor Injury. Perez was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Sunday, April 19, 2026 just before midnight, Thomas C. Bush (42) of Cadiz called 911 to report someone burglarizing his attic. Deputy Bobby Beeler responded to the residence in Lamasco and found nobody in the home. It was determined that Bush had been consuming Methamphetamine and also possessed the illegal drug. He was arrested by Deputy Beeler and charged with False Report to Law Enforcement and Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 2nd Offense (Methamphetamine). In addition, he was found to be a

fugitive from Montgomery County, TN. He was also charged with being a Fugitive from Justice. Bush was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
