



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Monday, April 20, 2026, around 10:30am, deputies served a criminal summons on Jessica D. Jones (33) of Kuttawa. She was charged with Parent or Custodian to Send Child to School-1st or 2nd Offense. She faces a May court date in Lyon District Court.
- On Tuesday, April 21, 2026, around 6:13pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler responded to a motorist assist complaint on KY 93 South. His investigation revealed a 2012 Mercedes Benz was being operated by Torriun Ar-Dwayne Young (32) of Atlanta, GA, with two flat tires. A check of his driver's license revealed his operator's license was revoked for failure to answer a court summons. In addition, Young was in possession of Marijuana at the time. It was also determined Young was a fugitive from Hardin County for a domestic violence related assault case. A passenger in the vehicle was identified as Javonna Montayzhia Looney (38) of Kansas City, MO who was also determined to be a fugitive from the state of Missouri. Both were arrested and their respective charges are as follows:
 - Torriun Ar-Dwayne Young (32) of Atlanta, GA
 - Complaint Warrant – Hardin County – Assault-4th Degree (Domestic Violence)
 - Operating on Suspended or Revoked Operator's License
 - Possession of Marijuana
 - Javonna Montayzhia Looney (38) of Kansas City, MO
 - Fugitive from Another State (Missouri)

Both subjects were lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center. Deputy Beeler was assisted by the Eddyville Police Department at the scene.

- On Wednesday, April 22, 2026, around 4:30pm, Deputy Josh Travis responded to a suspicious person complaint at a Kuttawa business. His investigation revealed James W. Patten (63) of Gilbertsville, had stolen \$582.75 worth of merchandise from the store and was in possession of many of the items at the time of the initial contact with Deputy Travis. Patten was arrested and charged with Theft by Unlawful Taking - \$500 - < \$1,000. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Thursday, April 23, 2026, around 11am, Sheriff Brent White arrested Tyree L. McGee (26) of Paducah and served him with a Lyon District Court bench warrant for Failure to Appear in court on a traffic case. McGee voluntarily surrendered on this date and posted a cash bond before being released.
- On Thursday, April 23, 2026, around 2:21pm, Deputies served a Clark County complaint warrant on Monica V. Goodwin (44) of Winchester, charging her with Non Support-1st Offense (child support). Goodwin awaits extradition back to Clark County.
- On Thursday, April 23, 2026, around 2:45pm, SRO Deputy Jason Young responded to a drug complaint, from staff, at the high school. William Nichols (18) of Kuttawa was found to be in possession of Marijuana vapes and related items. He was charged with Possession of Marijuana and dismissed from school. The investigation also led to the same charge against a 15-year-old female student, after she was also found in possession of Marijuana vapes. The student was dismissed from school and returned to a parent/guardian.
- On Thursday, April 23, 2026, around 8:40pm, Deputy Josh Travis served a Hopkins District Court bench warrant on James W. Patten (63) of Gilbertsville charging him with Failure to Appear in court on a traffic related offense. Patten remains incarcerated in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Saturday, April 25, 2026, around 11:30pm, Deputies Josh Travis and Bobby Beeler, along with Kentucky State Police, responded to a campground on Green Road for a disturbance complaint. Upon their arrival, they determined there were actually two separate disturbances within the campground. The investigation led to the following charges on the listed offenders:
 - Tammy K. Roof (55) of Kuttawa – charged with Assault-4th Degree and Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Offense (Methamphetamine).
 - Kevin R. Kesling (56) of Kuttawa – charged with Assault-4th Degree, Criminal Attempt Assault-1st Degree (knife/lethal cutting instrument), Disorderly Conduct-2nd Degree, and Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Offense (Methamphetamine).

- Lindsey A. Iron-Road (46) of Kuttawa – charged with Assault-4th Degree and Disorderly Conduct-2nd Degree.

All three offenders were lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
