- On Monday, April 27, 2026, around 9pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler served a Lyon Circuit Court bench warrant on Prince G. Koiyan (31) of Conyers, GA after he was extradited back to Kentucky from Georgia on this date. Koiyan previously failed to appear for a fourth offense DUI, third offense of driving on a DUI suspended license, and drug case in Circuit Court. He was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Tuesday, April 28, 2026, around 7:30am, SRO Deputy Cory Jessup was contacted by Lyon County School administration concerning several students who reportedly possessed THC vapes. An investigation was initiated and evidence was collected. SRO Deputy Jessup charged the following students with Possession of Marijuana:
 - 12-year-old female
 - 12-year-old female
 - 12-year-old female
 - 16-year-old female

The students were released to a parent or guardian.

- On Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at 3:20pm, deputies served a Pulaski Circuit Court indictment warrant on Rebekah J. Devore (43) of Somerset. She was charged with Receiving Stolen Property \$1,000 < \$10,000, Receiving Stolen Property-Firearm (2 counts), and Possession of Handgun by a Convicted Felon. Devore awaits extradition back to Pulaski County.

- On Friday, May 1, 2026, around 10am, deputies served a Clark County, Indiana arrest warrant on Everett M. Harris (47) of Louisville. Harris is an inmate in the Kentucky State Penitentiary. He was charged with Intimidation, Invasion of Privacy and Harassment. Harris awaits extradition back to Indiana following service of his Kentucky prison sentence.
