



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Monday, May 11, 2026, around 1:39pm, Deputies served a Grayson District Court bench warrant on James T. Ashby (68) of Caneyville for non-payment of court costs, fees, or fines. Ashby awaits extradition back to Grayson County.
- On Tuesday, May 12, 2026, around 11:14am, Deputies served a Lyon District Court criminal complaint on Mary D. Nixon (60) of Eddyville. She was charged with a Nuisance Ordinance violation and was summoned to Court in May.
- On Wednesday, May 13, 2026, around 3:33pm, Deputies served a Daviess District Court bench warrant on Heather R. Collier (37) of Central City for non-payment of court costs, fees, or fines. Collier awaits extradition back to Daviess County.
- On Wednesday, May 13, 2026, around 7:50pm, Sheriff Brent White served a Lyon District Court criminal complaint on Johnny D. Demello (59) of Eddyville. He was charged with a Nuisance Ordinance violation and was summoned to Court in May.
- On Thursday, May 14, 2026, around 2:13pm, Deputies served two Fugitive from Justice warrants on Andrew M. Allen (58) of Memphis, TN. Allen was wanted on Tennessee warrants charging him with a Probation Violation for an Evading Arrest conviction, whereby he absconded supervision. In addition, he was wanted for Evading Arrest, Open Container, Driving while License Revoked, Speeding, Display of Registration Plates, and Reckless Endangerment-Vehicle/Felony. Allen remains in custody while he awaits extradition proceedings in Lyon District Court.

- On Saturday, May 16, 2026, around 10:56am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams responded a domestic dispute at the intersection of US 62 and KY 295 South. His investigation revealed two people engaged in rolling domestic dispute in a vehicle until getting to this location, when one of the involved parties exited the vehicle. As Chief Deputy Adams arrived, he detained a male subject later identified as Bransen C. Kirkham (20) of Eddyville. Kirkham was determined to have an active warrant for his arrest. He was subsequently arrested on a Warren District Court bench warrant for Failure to Appear as it pertained to drug charges. Kirkham posted a cash bond and was released by the Lyon County Jailer.
- On Saturday, May 16, 2026, around 2pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams and Deputies of the Lyon County Sheriff's Office were providing security at the Bands on Barkley event at the Kuttawa Recreation Area. A person reported to Chief Deputy Adams that a registered sex offender was working in a mobile business trailer named "Ghost Grove". Deputies investigated the incident and positively identified Jessie L. Sherrill (59) of Princeton who was listed on the Kentucky Sex Offender Registry. He was found to operating in a mobile business and being present within 300 feet of a public playground in violation of sex offender restrictions. Chief Deputy Adams arrested Sherrill and charged him with Registered Sex Offender Public Playground Restrictions. Sherrill was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
