



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Sunday, June 7, 2026, around 7:30pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler and a Kentucky State Police Trooper were dispatched to a reckless driving complaint involving a black Toyota Prius traveling at a high rate of speed. Additional reports indicated this was possibly a rolling domestic dispute. Deputy Beeler located the vehicle on US 62 East near US 641 where the vehicle came to an abrupt stop on the side of the highway and an assault between the vehicle's occupants commenced. Deputy Beeler was able to detain both subjects. The female operator was identified as Elizabeth A. Jones (53) of Sedalia. She was arrested and charged with Possession of an Open Container of Alcoholic Beverage in Motor Vehicle and Assault-4th Degree (domestic violence).

A passenger, identified as Anthony J. Roberts (39) of Paducah, was arrested by a Kentucky State Trooper and charged with Assault-4th Degree (domestic violence). Both Jones and Roberts were lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Tuesday, June 9, 2026, just before 5pm, Deputies Bobby Beeler and Sam Adams were dispatched to a disturbance complaint on Valley Drive. Upon arrival, Deputies detained Trenton D. Riley (51) of Eddyville. He was found to be intoxicated and threatening family members with a multi-tool knife. He was arrested and charged with Menacing. Riley was previously arrested at the same location in March of 2026 and was out of custody on bond conditions which prohibited this conduct. The investigation is continuing and additional charges are pending.
- On Thursday, June 11, 2026, just before 7am, Sheriff Brent White observed a female, identified as Meagan N. Edwards (41) of Eddyville, operating a 2013 Chevrolet Equinox on US 62 East. Edwards was the subject of a complaint in May regarding her operating on a suspended license and failing to adhere to her license restrictions. Edwards' license was determined to be suspended for a prior DUI conviction. She was arrested and charged with Driving DUI Suspended License-2nd Offense. Edwards was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Thursday, June 11, 2026, around 11:10am, Deputies served a Laurel District Court bench warrant on Heather R. Huskey (27) of Williamsburg, for Non-payment of Court Costs, Fees, or Fines. Huskey awaits extradition back to Laurel County.
- On Thursday, June 11, 2026, around 11:25am, Sheriff Brent White served a Marshall County criminal complaint warrant on Kathy L. Kingston (50) of Kuttawa. The Benton Police Department investigated the incident involving Kingston whereby they reported she had stolen \$3,089.34 worth of merchandise from Wal-Mart in Benton from March 11, 2026 to May 27, 2026. She was charged with Theft by Unlawful Taking (\$1,000 < \$10,000). Kingston posted a cash bond and was released from custody.
- On Thursday, June 11, 2026, around 3:05pm, Sheriff Brent White served a McCracken District Court bench warrant on Joseph D. Bergman (28) of Paducah for Failure to Appear on a traffic related case. Bergman was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Saturday, June 13, 2026, just before 9pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler assisted a Kentucky State Police Trooper who made a traffic stop on a 2003 Infiniti for disregarding a stop sign at KY 810 and US62. The Trooper identified the driver as Joshua M. Rowlands (44) of Eddyville. He was arrested and charged with DUI-1st Offense as well as Disregarding Stop Sign. Following a blood test at the jail, he was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Sunday, June 14, 2026, at 9:45am, Sheriff Brent White served a Lyon Circuit Court indictment criminal summons on Amanda K. Overbaugh (36) of Kuttawa for one count of Possession of Handgun by a Convicted Felon. The case was investigated by Deputy Josh Travis. Overbaugh was already in custody, at the Crittenden County Detention Center, on similar charges from a previous indictment. She faces a July court date in Lyon Circuit Court on both indictment cases.
