



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On the evening of September 28, 2025, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office received a complaint regarding threats made to the high school from a student which were separate from the incident last Friday. Deputy Bobby Beeler, SRO Deputy Cory Jessup, and school administrators collaborated to identify the suspect and any witnesses to these threats.

Following a multi-hour investigation, it was determined the juvenile had made one alarming statement and one threatening statement to fellow students during the lockdown period following Friday's incident. Juveniles who overheard these statements reported it to their family members on Sunday evening, resulting in calls to school administrators and the Sheriff's Office.

In the early morning hours of Monday, September 29, 2025, a 15-year-old juvenile male was taken into custody by Deputy Bobby Beeler. The juvenile student was charged with Terroristic Threatening - 2nd Degree. He has since been lodged, this morning, in the McCracken Regional Juvenile Detention Center in Paducah.

It is unknown at this time if these incidents are related to the threat received on Friday; however, the Kentucky State Police and the Lyon County Sheriff's Office are continuing to investigate.

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
