

LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Monday, October 13, 2025, just after 3pm, Sheriff Brent White arrested a 16year-old male from Princeton on a juvenile complaint, following an investigation of a residential burglary which occurred at a home on KY 818 North in Lyon County on Monday, October 6, 2025. The male juvenile was charged with the following offenses:
 - Burglary-2nd Degree (by complicity)
 - Theft by Unlawful Taking <\$10,000 (by complicity)
 - Criminal Mischief-2nd Degree (by complicity)
 - Criminal Trespass-3rd Degree

The 16-year-old juvenile was lodged in the McCracken County Regional Juvenile Detention Center in Paducah.

- On Tuesday, October 14, 2025, at 3:01pm, SRO Deputies responded to an assault complaint at the High School involving a student who was injured in an altercation on campus. The investigation led to a 16-year-old male student from Eddyville being charged with Assault-4th Degree. The incident was captured on school surveillance video and the juvenile student victim required medical attention. The investigation is continuing with both District Court and administrative school disciplinary proceedings pending.
- On Wednesday, October 15, 2025, at 8am, Lyon County SRO Deputies detained a juvenile student at the High School, that Sheriff Brent White later arrested in relation to the same October 6, 2025 residential burglary on KY 818 North. The 16-year-old male from Kuttawa was served with a juvenile complaint and custody order, charging him with the following offenses:
 - Burglary-2nd Degree (by complicity)
 - Theft by Unlawful Taking <\$10,000 (by complicity)
 - Criminal Mischief-2nd Degree (by complicity)
 - Criminal Trespass-3rd Degree

The 16-year-old juvenile was lodged in the McCracken County Regional Juvenile Detention Center in Paducah, where he remains incarcerated as of this date.

The October 6th burglary and theft investigation is continuing with additional charges pending. The stolen property in the case, including two firearms (shotgun and handgun), clothing accessories, and an ATV have been recovered and returned to the victim.
