



## LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Sunday, February 1, 2026, around 12:20pm, Sheriff Brent White responded to a collision complaint on US 62 East in the city limits of Eddyville. His investigation revealed a 2006 Ford, F450 bus, driven by Archie L. Hudson (64) of Princeton, was East bound on US 62 when a large piece of snow/ice became dislodged from the roof of the bus and impacted a 2017 GMC Yukon, driven by Hannah Lowry (33) of Bowling Green. There were no injuries reported in the accident.
- On Monday, February 2, 2026, around 3pm, Sheriff Brent White arrested Joshua L. Williams (43) of Cookeville, TN on a bench warrant after he failed to appear in Lyon Circuit Court earlier in the day. Williams was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Monday, February 2, 2026, around 3:15pm, Chief Deputy Sam Adams arrested William M. McQuigg, Jr. (43) of Kuttawa. He was served with a Lyon Circuit Court bench warrant for Failure to Appear in court. McQuigg later posted a cash bond and was released from custody.
- On Monday, February 2, 2026, around 6:30pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler and Chief Deputy Sam Adams responded to a complaint of a man urinating in the parking lot of a Kuttawa business. Upon arrival, deputies located the man in his vehicle, passed out with the vehicle's engine running. He was identified as Todd B. Santee (53) of Kolomo, IN. Santee was administered field sobriety tests and subsequently arrested. He was charged by Deputy Beeler with DUI-1<sup>st</sup> Offense and Possession of Open Alcoholic Beverage Container in a Motor Vehicle. Santee was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Monday, February 2, 2026, around 8:15pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler responded to a Kuttawa business for a two-vehicle collision in their parking lot. His investigation revealed a 2020 International truck, driven by Davis A. Mikel (43) of Rogersville, MT collided with a parked 2020 Volvo semi-truck owned by USA Transport of Lexington, KY. No injuries were reported in the accident.

- On Tuesday, February 3, 2026, around 2:52pm deputies charged Anthony La Bonte (29) of Berea, with a Madison District Court bench warrant for Failure to Appear in court as it pertained to a 2019 Contempt of Court charge. La Bonte is awaiting extradition back to Madison County.
- On Tuesday, February 3, 2026, around 3:45pm, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a "shots fired" complaint in the Palisades subdivision. Their investigation led to a residence in the 900 block of Palisades Drive where an active domestic disturbance was on-going. Deputies detained a man and woman and determined what was initially thought to be gunfire was actually the male colliding with the female's vehicle in the driveway of their residence. A physical altercation between the two parties continued into the residence following the driveway incident, and until deputies arrived to separate them. Chief Deputy Sam Adams arrested Kathy G. Pendley (52) of Eddyville and charged her with Assault-4<sup>th</sup> Degree (domestic violence) Minor Injury. Deputy Bobby Beeler arrested Rafe A. Pendley (53) of Eddyville and charged him with Assault-4<sup>th</sup> Degree (domestic violence) Minor Injury. Both Pendley subjects were later lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Wednesday, February 4, 2026, just after 6pm, Deputy Josh Travis and an Eddyville Police Department officer located and arrested Stephen M. Clark (42) at a business off US 62 East. Clark was the subject of a Failure to Appear bench warrant from Lyon Circuit Clerk whereby he failed to appear in court on the previous Monday in a child support case. Clark was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Wednesday, February 4, 2026, around 8:27pm, Deputy Shannon Oliver and Deputy Josh Travis located and arrested Heather D. Thornton (46) of Kuttawa at a residence on Joe Peek Road. Thornton was served with two (2) Failure to Appear bench warrants whereby she failed to appear in two drug-related cases in Lyon Circuit Court. Thornton was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Thursday, February 5, 2026 around 8:43am, deputies served a Lee Circuit Court indictment warrant on Samuel Logsdon (50), address unknown. He faces extradition back to Lee County to answer charges including Assault-2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Persistent Felony Offender-I.
- On Friday, February 6, 2026, just after 1pm, deputies served a Probation Violation (for Felony Offense) bench warrant from Lyon Circuit Court on Kathy G. Pendley (52) of Eddyville. She remains lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Friday, February 6, 2026, just before 1:30pm, deputies served a Probation Violation (for Felony Offense) bench warrant from Lyon Circuit Court on Rafe A. Pendley (53) of Eddyville. He remains lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.
- On Friday, February 6, 2026, at 10pm, Deputy Josh Travis charged Jessica L. Chapman (42) of Princeton with Possession of Marijuana after she was found to be in possession of a jar of marijuana bud and two marijuana cigarettes at a Traffic Safety Checkpoint on US 62. Chapman was cited to Lyon District Court.
- On Saturday, February 7, 2026, around 2:20am, Deputy Josh Travis detained Amanda K. Overbaugh (aka: Amanda Rowlands), (36) of Kuttawa, off KY 1055 near a campground, following a trespassing complaint received by the Sheriff's Office and a report of a motorist assist in the same area. Overbaugh was found to be in possession of a handgun and ammunition when contacted by law enforcement. She is a prohibited person due to her previously being convicted of multiple burglary offenses and Methamphetamine related offenses. She was recently charged in an unrelated criminal trespassing incident, near Kuttawa, at a construction site, which is still pending in Lyon District Court, and which she was out of custody on bond at the time of this incident. Deputy Travis arrested and charged Overbaugh with Possession of a Handgun by a Convicted Felon. She was later lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center. The Eddyville Police Department assisted Deputy Travis with this arrest. The investigation is continuing.
