



## LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

(1) Following the standoff incident on Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at the Dollar General store on KY 293, South of Eddyville, the Lyon County Sheriff's Office continued its investigation of the two offenders arrested in that incident. Beginning in the early morning hours of Wednesday, February 25, 2026 and continuing until after midnight on Thursday, February 26, 2026, additional evidence was recovered from the scene as well as a search warrant execution on the stolen vehicle they were occupying at the time of their arrest. These offenders now face additional charges listed below:

### **Thomas J. Prevatte**

- Trafficking Controlled Substance-1<sup>st</sup> Degree, 1<sup>st</sup> Offense (> 2 grams of Methamphetamine)
- Drug Paraphernalia-Buy/Possess
