



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Tuesday, March 3, 2026, around 5:47pm, Deputy Josh Travis responded to a two-vehicle collision in Suwanee at the intersection of US 62 West and KY 810 South. The investigation revealed a 2013 Ford Edge, driven by Maryline F. Mead (77) of Kuttawa was stopped in traffic waiting to turn from US 62 onto KY 810 South. A 2000 Freightliner, driven by Leyva R. Oniel (45) of Louisville, was West on US 62 and overtaking the Mead vehicle. Oniel was inattentive and did not realize the Mead vehicle was stopped to turn. As Oniel approached to the rear of the Mead vehicle, he swerved to the left in an attempt to avoid a collision; however, the passenger side of his semi-trailer collided with the Mead vehicle, forcing it into a guardrail. There were no injuries reported. Eddyville Police Dept., Kuttawa Fire Dept. and Lyon County EMS assisted Deputy Travis at the scene.
- On Wednesday, March 4, 2026, around 8am, Chief Deputy Sam Adams served a criminal complaint and court summons on Colby W. Cubbedge (26) of West Paducah for Theft by Deception (including cold checks) \$1,000 to less than \$10,000. Cubbedge will appear in Caldwell District Court on March 16th to answer for this offense.
- On Thursday, March 5, 2026, around 7:17pm, Deputy Shannon Oliver responded to a single vehicle collision on KY 818 North near Dulaney Road. His investigation revealed Christopher C. Pierce (17) of Eddyville was traveling North on KY 818 when a deer entered the roadway. Pierce swerved to avoid the deer; however, he lost control, leaving the roadway and traveling up a steep embankment before overturning. Pierce refused medical treatment at the scene. The Eddyville Fire Dept., Eddyville Police Dept., and Lyon County EMS assisted Deputy Oliver at the scene.
- On Friday, March 6, 2026, around 7:48am, the Sheriff's Office was asked to assist the Eddyville Police Department with a theft complaint. The initial investigation revealed an unidentified, white female, was trespassing at a closed business in the early morning hours on this date. She is believed to have stolen items from a toolbox and other items before communicating on a cellular phone

as determined by surveillance camera footage. She was then picked up by an unidentified driver of a dark colored passenger car, which had its headlamps off, before leaving the area. - On Friday, March 6, 2026, around 4:39pm, Deputies and Troopers responded to a shots-fired complaint at a residence in the 1000 block of Friendship Road. During the investigation, a search warrant was obtained for the property and the subsequent search revealed Methamphetamine, two handguns, Marijuana, pills, and drug paraphernalia. Deputy Travis arrested Earl B. Molloy, III (64) of Eddyville. He was charged with the following offenses:
 - Possession of Handgun by Convicted Felon (2 counts)
 - Trafficking in Controlled Substance-1st Degree, (> 2 grams Methamphetamine) Firearm Enhanced
 - Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 1st Offense (Opiates)
 - Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 1st Offense (Hydrocodone)
 - Possession of Marijuana
 - Drug Paraphernalia-Possession

Molloy was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center. Deputy Travis was assisted at the scene by Deputy Shannon Oliver, the Eddyville Police Dept. and Kentucky State Police.

Following an on-scene investigation, Deputy Oliver arrested Trenton D. Riley (51) of Eddyville. Riley was charged with Assault-4th Degree (domestic violence). He was later lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

Two females and a male entered the store after parking a Tennessee registered vehicle. While inside the store, management reported the two females stole merchandise before fleeing the area in a silver, Buick sedan. They were last seen on KY 293 heading toward KY 93 South.
