



LYON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MEDIA RELEASE

- On Sunday, March 15, 2026, around 5:50pm, Deputies responded to a Saratoga residence to serve an arrest warrant on a subject who was reported to be there. Upon arrival, Deputy Bobby Beeler arrested Caleb M. Wellborn (30) of Eddyville and charged him on a Lyon District Court bench warrant for failure to appear. While at this location, Sheriff Brent White recognized a subject on Parole for trafficking in Methamphetamine previously in Lyon County. Probation and Parole Officers were contacted after it was determined this subject was in violation of his Parole conditions by associating with a convicted felon at this residence. A search of a vehicle revealed Marijuana, Methamphetamine, and multiple items of drug paraphernalia. Michael W. Reed (47) of Calvert City was also arrested by Deputy Beeler and charged with Possession of Controlled Substance-1st Degree, 2nd Offense; Possession of Marijuana; and Drug Paraphernalia Possession. Both Wellborn and Reed were later lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

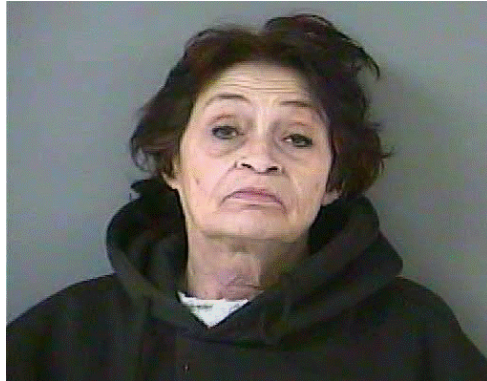

- On Monday, March 16, 2026, around noon, SRO Deputy Jason Young was in the high school when he heard a disturbance in a lobby area. Further investigation determined a 14-year-old male student assaulted another student while unprovoked. This led to an additional altercation involving the victim and the 14-year-old male. All the events were captured on video surveillance. SRO Deputy Young charged the juvenile with Assault-4th Degree and the student was removed from school and released to the custody of a parent.

- On Monday, March 16, 2026, around 7:48pm, Deputy Bobby Beeler was on patrol on Chestnut Oak Road when he observed a vehicle, driven by a female with an active arrest warrant. A traffic stop was conducted near Green Road where Tonya M. Breaux (65) of Kuttawa, was arrested on a Lyon Circuit Court bench warrant for Probation Violation (for felony offense). In addition, she was also charged with Failure to Wear Seat Belts, Possession of Marijuana, and Drug Paraphernalia Possession. Breaux was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Wednesday, March 18, 2026, around 7:22am, Deputies served a complaint warrant on Brandon S. Ausherman (35) of Eddyville. Ausherman was charged with Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument-1st Degree and Theft by Deception-Including Cold Checks. Ausherman is accused of passing counterfeit currency at businesses in Kuttawa. He stands accused of similar offenses in Christian County. Ausherman was lodged in the Crittenden County Detention Center.

- On Wednesday, March 18, 2026, around 12:22pm, Deputies served a Warren District Court bench warrant on Jessie A. Pytko (37), of Bowling Green, charging her with Non-payment of Court Costs, Fees, or Fines. Pytko faces extradition back to Warren County.

- On Saturday, March 21, 2026, just after 1pm, Deputy Josh Travis responded to a two-vehicle, non-injury collision on KY 93 at the intersection with KY 293 and KY 1055. His investigation revealed a 2014 GMC Sierra, driven by Dakota J. Shaw (22) of Carrollton, GA was stopped at the stop sign on KY 1055, preparing to cross over KY 93 and onto KY 293. Shaw failed to yield the right-of-way and pulled into the path of a North bound 2011 GMC Acadia, driven by Eric S. Johnson (60) of Eddyville. No injuries were reported in the collision. The Kuttawa Fire Chief assisted Deputy Travis at the scene.
