

# **Our Church Directory is Online!**

# View our church directory online or via the FREE mobile app today.

Our online pictorial directory is now live! If you are a parishioner at the Cathedral of St. Raymond please upload a family picture to the online directory. This is a great way for our priests, staff and fellow parishioners to better get to know one another.

Our community is constantly changing: new members join, families can change and children grow up. Our parish directory should reflect these changes. Traditional directories were designed to be around for a while because of the money, time and effort invested in them. With an online directory, new members can be added and growing families can be updated on an on-going basis. The decision of ordering enough copies for distribution would disappear and result in a cost savings to our parish.

Using a digital directory, parishioners will have password-based access at any time and can update their photos and information accordingly.

To view our new directory online, go to **members.InstantChurchDirectory.com** and follow the prompts under "Sign In" to "Create a login." Please remember, you must confirm your email address before you can sign in.

There is also a free mobile app available for download at the Apple® App store in iTunes®, Google Play™ store and the Amazon Fire App Store. Simply search for "Instant Church Directory" to get the download.

You will need to use your email address as listed in our directory to create a log-in the first time you use the directory online and via the mobile app. If you do not remember what email you used when registering, please call us.

There are a number a ways to have your photo added to the directory:

- 1. Drop off your photo at the parish or school office. We will scan and return your photo to you the same day.
- 2. Drop your photo in the Sunday collection with your name and contact number on the envelope. We will call you to pick up your photo once uploaded.

- 4. If you need someone to take a current photo of you or your family, stop by the parish office and a staff member will be happy to assist you.

## Eucharistic Miracles Poster Exhibit January 27 & 28 — after Mass Commons Room A & C





Come, learn about 15 year old Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991-2006). When Carlo was seven, he wrote, "To always be united to Jesus, this is my life plan." Ever since his First Holy Communion, he took every opportunity to attend daily Mass. He said, "The more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven." the modern day teen who dedicated his life to Jesus and traveled around the globe to catalogue the Eucharistic Miracles.

Travel back in time to the first Eucharistic miracle in Lanciano, Italy. During Mass, the Lord chose to reveal his true presence to a monastic priest who struggled to accept our Lord's Word, "This is my body, this is my blood, given up for you." During the two-fold consecration, the host changed into live Flesh and the wine has changed into live Blood, which coagulated into five globules.





Pause in Portugal, to learn about the woman who in 1237 hid the Eucharist in her kerchief. On her way home, the host started bleeding so she hid the kerchief in a trunk. In the middle of the night, the trunk emitted a radiant light and the townspeople flocked to her house to worship the Eucharist. The host was returned to the tabernacle and continued to bleed for three days. The woman's house was converted into a chapel in 1864 and is still a popular Portuguese pilgrimage destination.

Wrap up your Eucharistic Miracle tour around the world in the diocese of Chilpancingo-Chilapa, Mexico. While distributing Holy Communion to the faithful, sister turned to the priest celebrant with tears in her eyes and showed him that one of the hosts in her ciborium had begun to emit a reddish substance. Filled with amazement, and unsure what to make of the host, the priests informed the bishop. The blood type was found to be AB, which corresponds to the miracles at Buenos Aires and Lanciano.





Your stroll through the exhibit of 40 panels that detail accounts of the events, authentic documentation and photos of relics and other interesting images will enliven your understanding of the Real Presence — The Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar is truly the body, blood, soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ.


