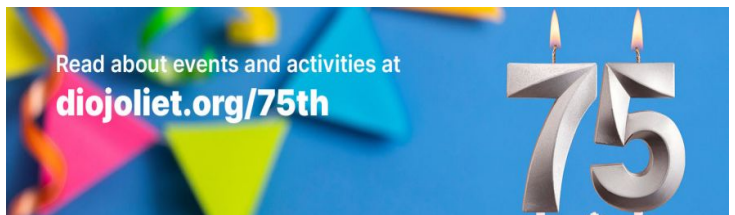

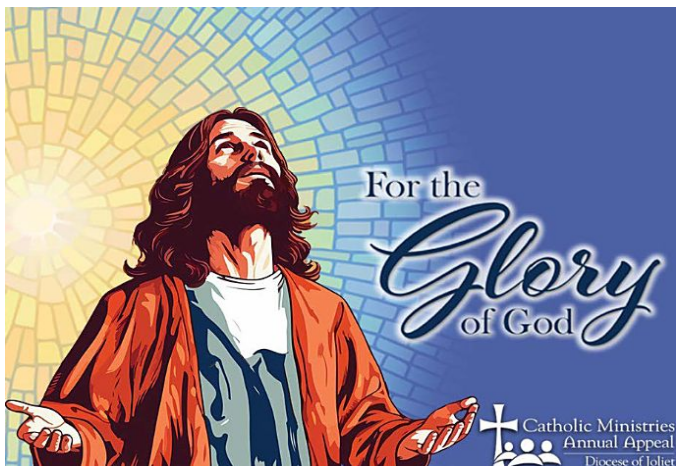

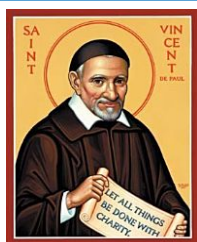
Lenten Adoration
