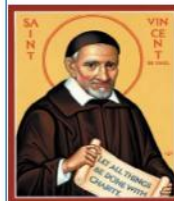

This month, through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was able to assist families, providing in food, help for utilities, rent and other bills.

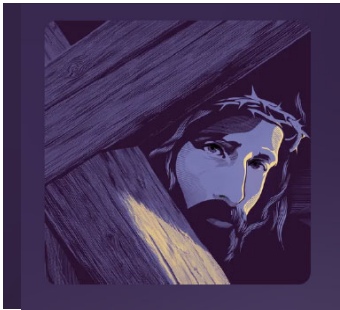

RECONNECT THIS LENT

Ash Wednesday, is the beginning of the season of Lent, when we will spend 40 days preparing for Easter with prayer, fasting and almsgiving. This season reminds us to retrace our steps and focus on things that lead us toward GOD, to love our neighbor and fulfill our mission that Christ entrusted to us. We invite you to enter this Lenten season with a contrite heart and a desire to reconnect.

Here are some ways to reconnect this Lent:

† Lenten Mission

We invite you to join us for our Parish Mission on **Sunday, February 25, "You Who Come To Me Shall Not Hunger"** A reflection on the Eucharist, according to John with Deacon Darrell Kelsey.

† Mass, Confession and Adoration

The **Holy Mass** is the highest form of prayer! This Lent, we encourage you to rededicate yourself to attending Mass, perhaps during the week as well as Sunday.

Confession is available every Saturday beginning at 4:00pm. Deanery wide confessions are scheduled for **Friday, March 22 from 3:00—7:00pm** here at the Cathedral.

Adoration will be offered following our **Saturday 8:00am Mass on February 17 & 24 and on March 2, 16, 23.** Come sit in silence with our Lord and spend time with Him, free from distraction.

† Attend Reflections of Lent—A Cathedral Concert

Saturday, March 16 at 7:00pm in the Cathedral. Featuring Matthew Agnew, Cello, Stacy Sienko and the Cathedral Choir.

† Pray the Rosary

One way we can grow in holiness this Lent is by incorporating the Rosary into our daily practices and Lenten observances. Meditating on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary will assist you in your love for Jesus and His sacrifice.

† Stations of the Cross

Stations of the Cross will be held on **Fridays during Lent at 7:00pm in the Cathedral. Good Friday stations will be prayed at 6:00pm.**

† Community Care and St. Vincent de Paul

Almsgiving and caring for those in need are part of our Christian Lenten Discipline. We encourage you to make this a habit by sacrificing non-essential spending for a greater good. Consider volunteering and financially supporting our St. Vincent de Paul Society, our micro pantry or by volunteering at one of our local food pantries.

† Hallow



Just as we did in Advent, we have partnered with Hallow to present "Lent Pray40 Prayer Challenge." Pray each day, be inspired by meditations, and deepen your relationship with Jesus.

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the **physically or mentally ill** including individuals suffering from **chronic illnesses** such as **diabetes**. Also excluded are **pregnant or nursing women**.
