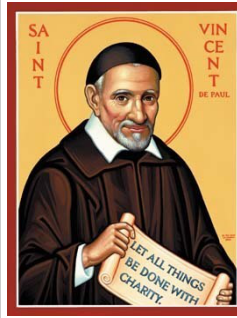




Online Giving

- Online Giving is a web-based application that allows you to start, stop and change your contributions at any time.
- Account and contribution information is encrypted and stored securely.
- Online Giving is very easy to use and requires no special knowledge other than how to access the internet.
- Parishioners who use the service are pleased with how easy it is to set up and manage.
- Once you have an account set up, you have the freedom to set up your own donation schedule, view completed and scheduled transactions, and make changes and updates on a 24 hour per day basis.
- You can make contributions from your checking or savings account, credit or debit card.
- When travel, illness or other circumstances prevent you from attending services, this program allows your offering to continue on an uninterrupted basis.
- You may print a statement at any time. Go to "My Online Giving History" for a printable record of your donations. In addition, the Parish Office will continue to send the "end of year statement" in January with your donations listed.

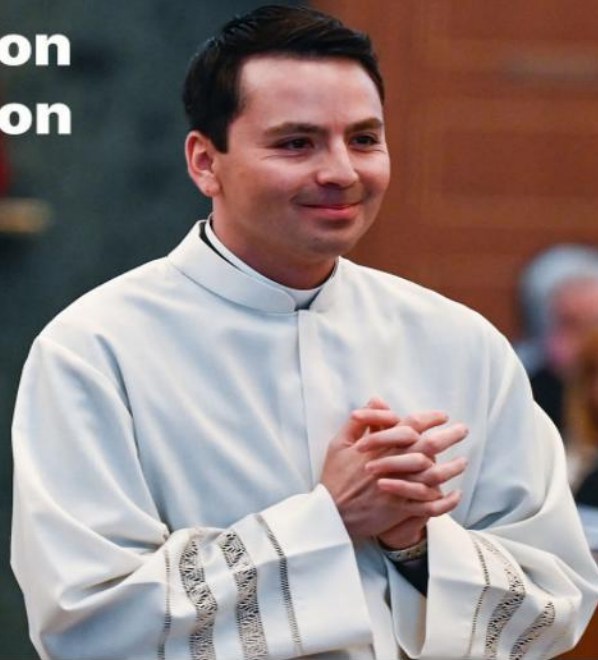

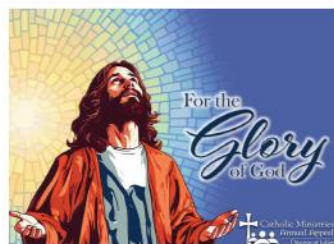
