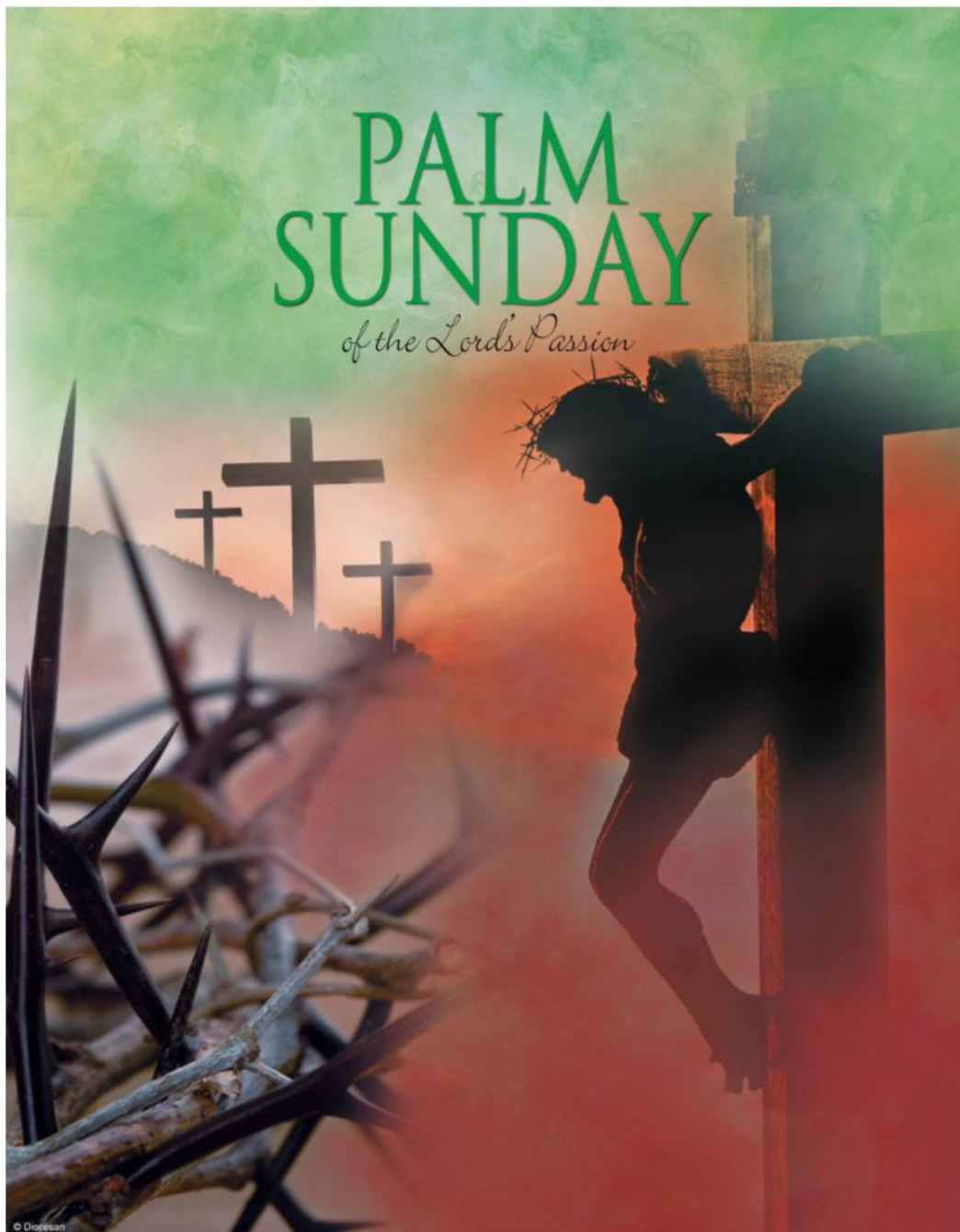

HOW THE PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION IS USED

A portion of the funds are directly allocated to the educational and ecclesial projects in the Middle East. The rest of the funds collected in the United States and a number of other countries support the ministries and programs entrusted by the Holy See to the Holy Land Franciscans. The Franciscans have served in the Holy Land for 800 years. Paschal Triduum

The **Easter Triduum** or **Holy Triduum** is the three-day celebration of the **Paschal Mystery**: the Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ

PASCHAL: associated with the Hebrew **Passover**; referring to Jesus as the Lamb of God
TRIDUUM: derived from the Latin for **three days**

The Paschal mystery has two aspects: **by his death**, Christ liberates us from sin; **by his Resurrection**, he opens for us the way to a new life.

The Paschal Triduum bridges the seasons of **Lent** to **Easter**.

In the Sacred Triduum, the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen.

The Roman Missal

HOLY THURSDAY:

"Jesus gives himself to us as food and, in the washing of feet, teaches us the need to serve others."

GOOD FRIDAY:

"In the mystery of Christ's death on the cross, we contemplate that undying divine love which embraces all mankind and summons us in turn to love one another in the power of the Spirit."

HOLY SATURDAY:

"The day of God's silence - invites us not only to solidarity with all who are abandoned and alone, but also to trust in that faithful love which turns death into life."

CHRISM MASS: Why is this Mass special?

Two significant things happen at this unusual Mass:

1. All the priests from the Diocese come to renew their promise of obedience to their Bishop.
2. The Holy Oils that are used for the coming year are blessed or consecrated, that is, set apart for sacred use.



Why are all the priests there? Diocesan priests are encouraged to attend to renew their promise of obedience to Bishop Hicks and their calling to the priesthood. It is also their opportunity to enjoy each other's company and celebrate Mass together as a community of pastors. The Bishop's homily will be one encouraging them to strive for holiness and to live their promises more perfectly. His encouragement to them can be taken for every Christian as well, to always try to be more like Jesus, to turn away from sin, and take joy in the love that God has for us as his children.

What are the three oils that are blessed? The first type is the Oil of the Sick, used in the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick for those who are seriously ill, infirm, or near death. The second is the Oil of Catechumens, used in the Sacrament of Baptism and in preparation for Baptism as an adult. The third is the Oil of Chrism, used in the Sacrament of Baptism of infants (to show the connection of Baptism to the Sacrament of Confirmation), and in the Sacrament of Confirmation, and in the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

The Diocese of Joliet Chrism Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral on Monday, April 14. This is a ticketed event.

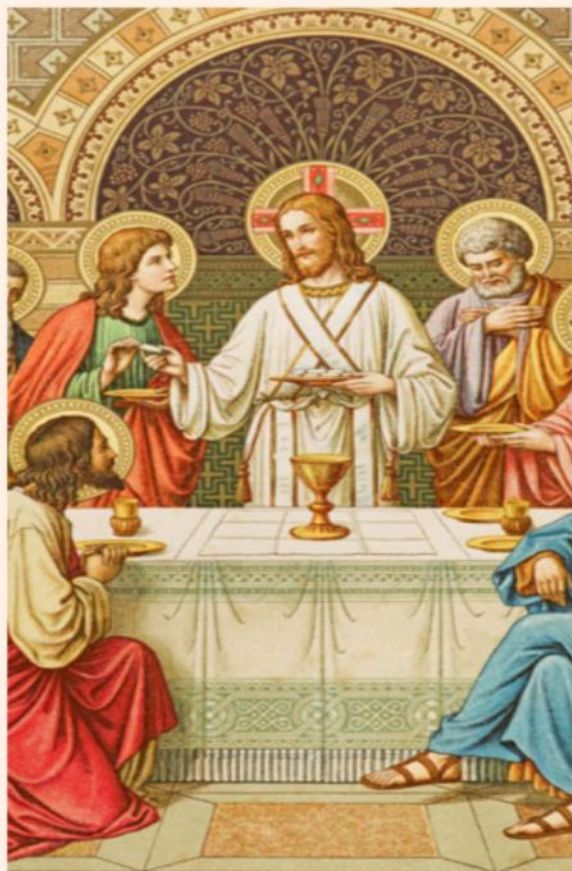

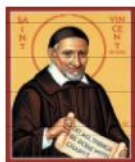


