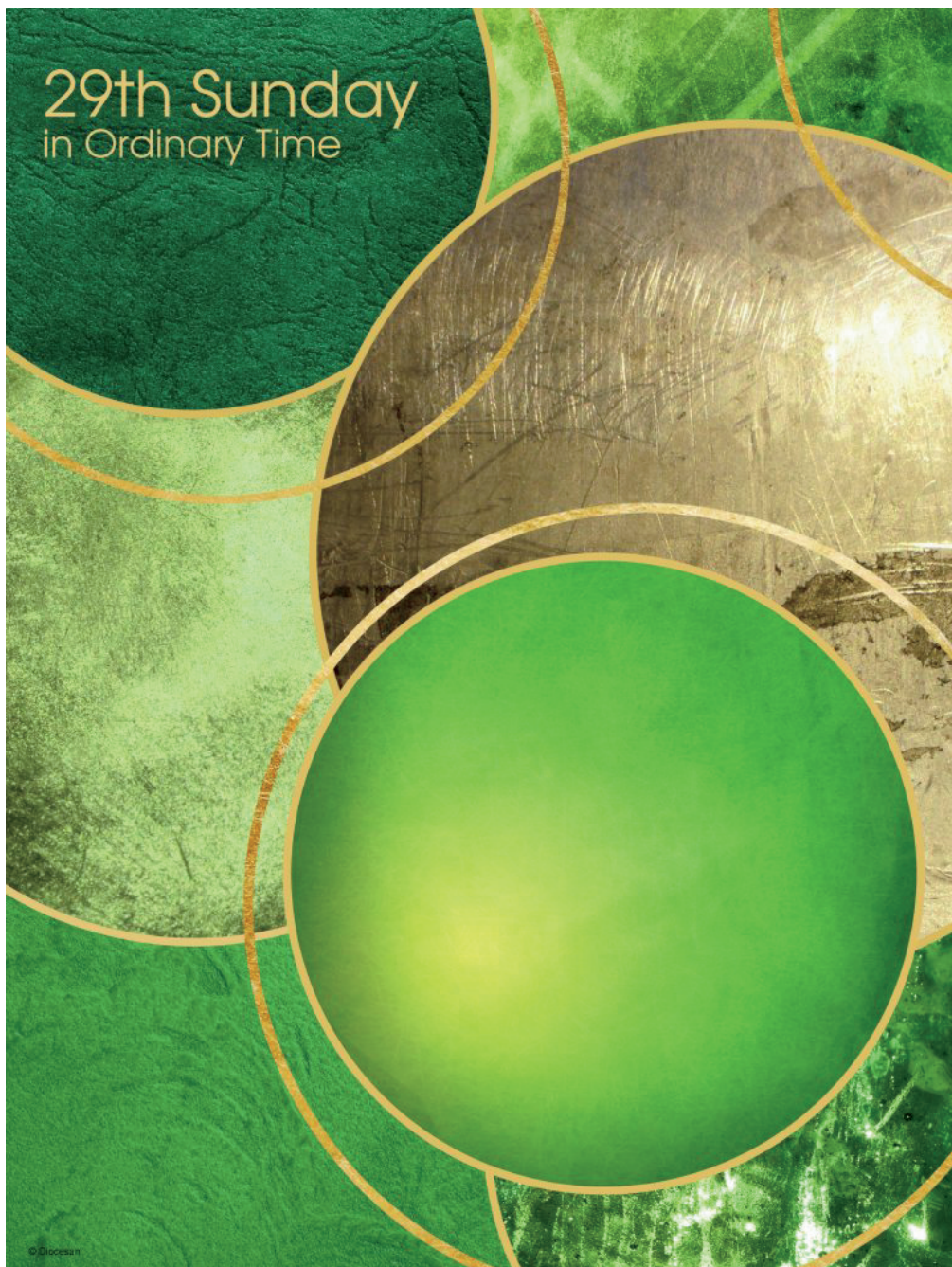

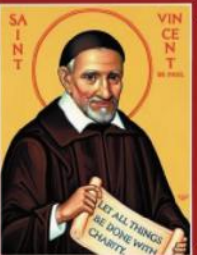

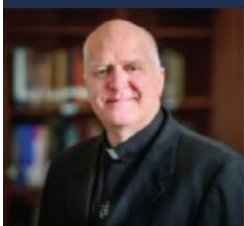
Join us at the beautiful Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus for Mass on Sunday, November 16, 2025.

The Notre Dame Club of Joliet is pleased to host the 2025 Hesburgh Lecture:

Perspectives on Family & Individual Wellness: Adolescent Moral Development

Notre Dame is focused on educating the whole person - mind, body, and spirit. This talk will focus on moral reasoning and identity formation of adolescents and emerging adults. The lecture encourages intellectual dialogue and engagement centered around various aspects of health such as personality and character development.

Our Guest Speaker Rev. James M. Lies, C.S.C., '87 M.A., is a Notre Dame Senior Advisor for Faculty Engagement and Partnerships with the Nanovic Institute for European Studies in the Keough School for Global Affairs. Fr. Jim is a priest of the Congregation of Holy Cross and leads efforts to advance global scholarship and identify research opportunities in collaboration with campus and Notre Dame's global network. He provides oversight for Notre Dame's G.K. Chesterton Collection, recently acquired from the Oxford Oratory, and he teaches in the undergraduate program.

Fr. Jim earned his B.A. from the University of St. Thomas in Minnesota; an M.A. from the University of Notre Dame; an M.Div. from the Jesuit School of Theology at Berkeley (now affiliated with Santa Clara University); and a Ph.D. in psychology from the University of Minnesota.

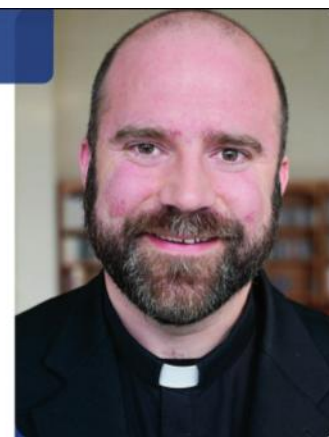

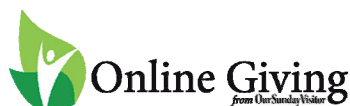
