

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is dedicated to bringing Faith into Action. Inspired by our patron, St. Vincent de Paul, our members grow in faith and hope as we meet with friends-in-need. But none of this ministry happens without you. Your generosity is what makes hope tangible for families we encounter.

Below is our most recent fiscal year 10/1/2024 – 9/30/2025 financial statements. We hope this give you an understanding of how your donations are being shared.



This past year, our SVDP conference responded to more than 160 calls through our helpline and made more than 65 home visits. A home visit is when 2 members of our ministry go into the homes of our friends (those we help) to hear their stories. We assisted 175+ friends in our community. We provided mattresses to 18 families, helped furnish homes for formerly homeless neighbors, and supplied food and clothing to those facing hardship. SVDP also "twinned" on 6 different occasions. Twining is when one conference helps another because a friend is outside their boundaries or when the financial request is rather large. We also made Christmas was a little brighter for 4 of our families in our community.

In addition, SVDP partners with Will Grundy Medical Center to help furnish homes for the once homeless. We have also established a partnership with Guardian Angel Home to assist women staying at their shelter. This December the Cathedral Area Preservation Association (CAPA) provided us with 40+ meal kits to give to families at our home visits.

Sadly the St. Vincent Thrift Store on Jefferson Street closed in October. This caused SVDP to seek out other local options to support our families. Just recently, we partnered with Morningstar Treasure Chest Thrift Store and we hope this will be a long-term solution for basic needs of clothing and home furnishings.

On behalf of our 17 active members and the many neighbors we serve, thank you for being partners in this Vincentian mission of charity, dignity, and hope.
