We would be thankful for your prayerful consideration of joining the ministry.

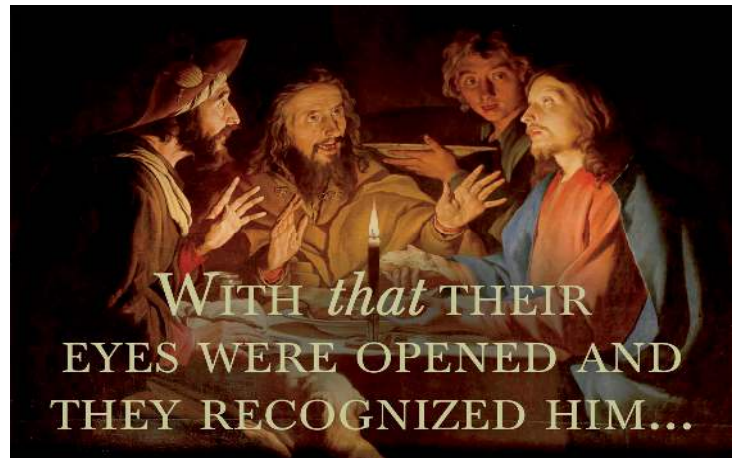

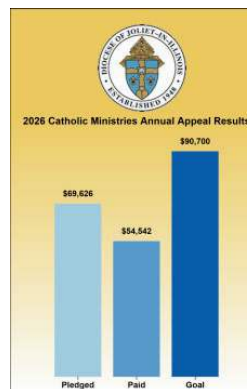
