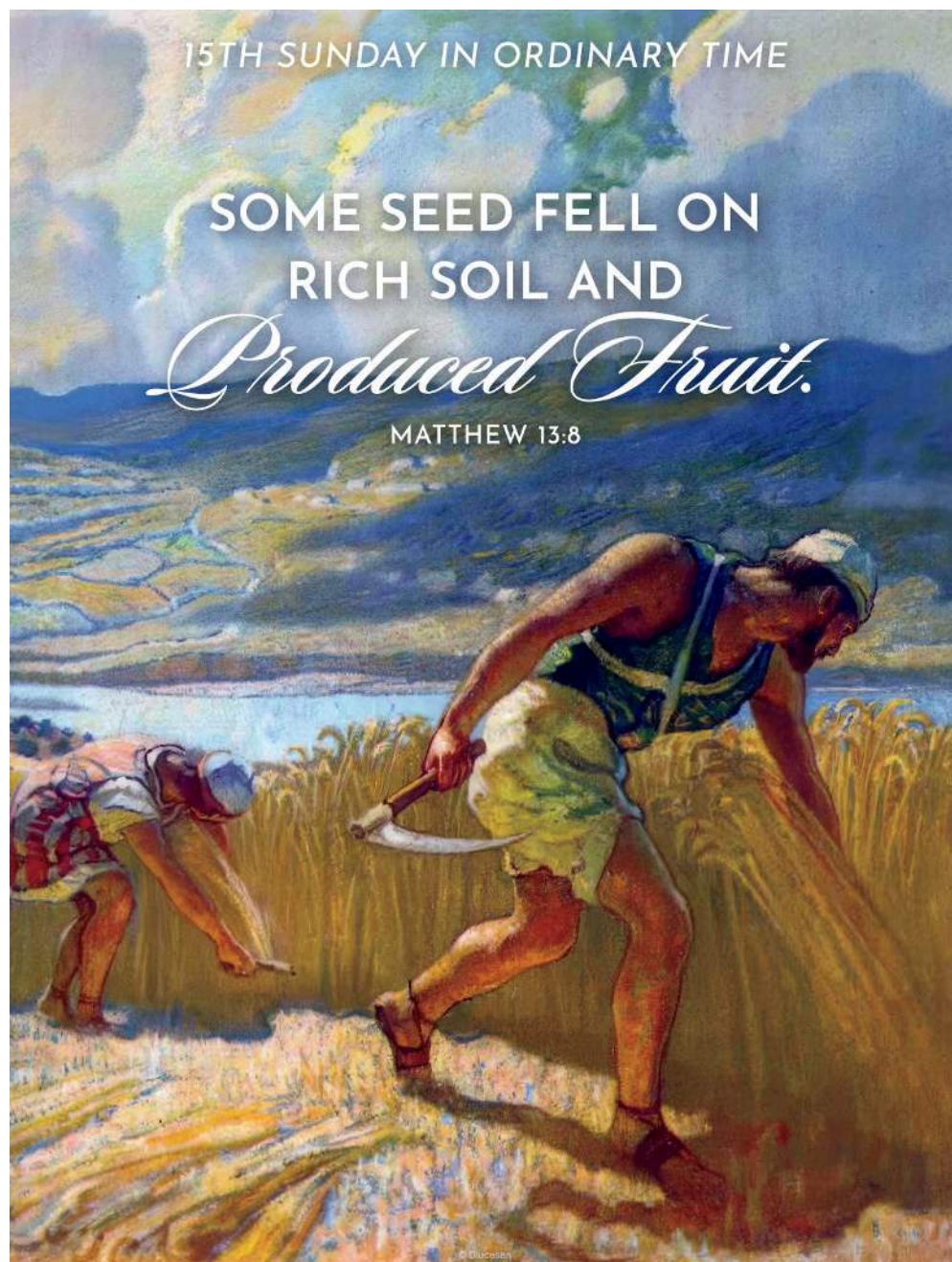

Anointing of the Sick: If you or a loved one is in need of the Anointing of the Sick, please call the Parish Office to arrange a visit with a priest.

Baptism: Please call the parish office to make arrangements or visit our website to complete a Baptism Request Form. First time parents will need to attend a Baptism Preparation Workshop. In order to serve as a Catholic Godparent, one must be a practicing Catholic who has been confirmed.

Marriage: Couples requesting a wedding must be registered for a minimum of six months before a date can be secured. Please contact the parish office a year in advance.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults): Contact us for further information regarding the instruction for those discerning whether to become members of our Catholic community and how to begin the process.

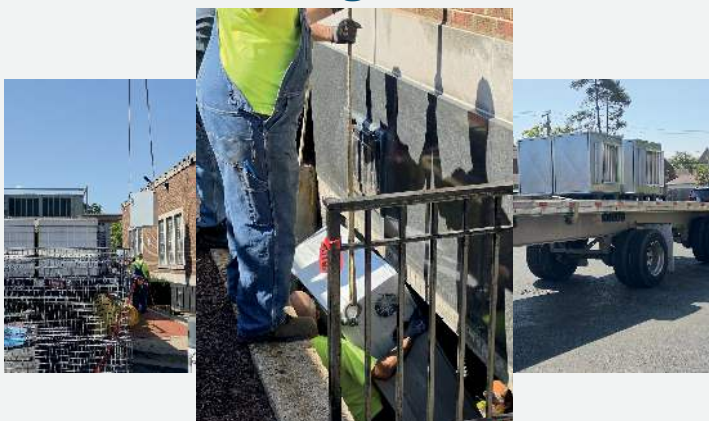

Air Handling Unit Arrived!



This week, a large crane arrived to help lift the new chiller and air handling units off the delivery truck.

It took some careful teamwork between the rigging crew and our HVAC contractors to make sure everything went smoothly and the units were safely positioned.

The chiller was placed outside behind the Cathedral.

The air handling unit had to be taken apart to fit into the Cathedral boiler room. Once it's lowered in, it will take about a week to be re-assembled.

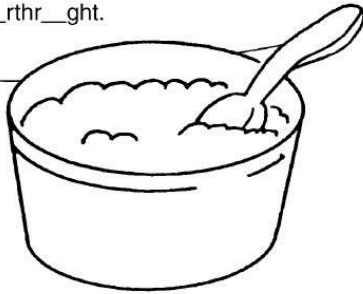

Reporting Sexual Abuse
