

TOWN OF MANVILLE OTHER CHARGES

Deposit for utility service \$100.00. This shall be paid before the utilities are turned on. If you move and tell the office, the utility charges will stop. The deposit will be applied to your bill; you are still responsible for the balance. If there is credit on your account this will be refunded to you.

Late Fee-10% of balance due

Return check fee \$35.00

*When a resident (homeowner) moves (goes south for the winter) and requests that the water be shut off. There will be a \$10.00 charge to turn the water off. The party responsible will pay a tap each month. This will prevent the meter from being removed. If the water is left on, they owe the monthly water/sewer fee.

A fee of \$10.00 will be charged to restore service, after any service has been turned off for any reason.

If the meter is removed for any reason, the party responsible will need to pay \$550.00 to have the meter reinstalled. If there is a balance due on account, this will need to be brought to a zero first.

**The office will diligently do their best to collect utility payments from the renter. If we are unable to collect after a reasonable amount of time the owner will become responsible for paying the bill.

Customer/owner will pay a dumpster fee until they ask for it to be removed.

For a completely new service, the charge will be no less than \$3,000.00.

Bucket load of gravel \$25.00

Load of gravel \$125.00

Outside bulk water sales are .03 per gallon

Charge for copies .50 a page (one sided), must be picked up in the office.

Fax charge .50. If a cover page is needed and extra pages printed, there will be an additional fee.

Charge for use of equipment, sewer snake, camera, etc. \$75.00 an hour with one hour minimum

School rental-Deposit \$60.00 (refundable if left clean) \$60.00 daily use fee. This is to be paid in advance.

Cemetery charges are for opening the cemetery and digging a plot.

Grave \$250.00

Cremation \$75.00

Prices are subject to change each fiscal year as council deems necessary.

Commercial Water Definition

Commercial Water Use means use of water related to the production, sale or delivery of goods, services or commodities by a public or private entity. These uses include, but are not limited to, construction, operation and maintenance of commercial facilities.

Examples of commercial facilities include, but are not limited to, an office, recreational facility, motel, hotel, gas station, kennel, store, medical facility, and veterinary office.

Examples of water uses in such facilities include, but are not limited to, human consumption, sanitation, food processing, and fire protection. Such uses shall not include irrigation or landscape maintenance of more than ½ acre. Notwithstanding this definition the Town Council may at their discretion grant any waivers or exemptions to said definitions.
