From the Pastor's Desk

Grace and peace to you all in the name of Jesus!

As we continue in our season of growing through prayer and thanksgiving, I want to reflect some on prayer. Prayer is not a way for us to earn God's favor, nor is it meant to be a looming obligation. Instead it is a gift, a joy that we have the opportunity to experience and participate in as we lean into the relationship we have with God. Because we are named God's beloved children and brought into right relationship with God by grace through faith, we are free to come before God honestly - with our loudest praise, most difficult questions, greatest gratitude, deepest sorrow, deafening silence, and greatest need. Prayer is one way our daily faith takes shape: learning again and again to trust the God who has first showered us with mercy and love.

Scripture reminds us that prayer is not limited to eloquent words or perfect concentration. Paul writes, "*Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with groanings too deep for words*" (Romans 8:26). This is good news: even when our prayers feel scattered, tired, or wordless; even when our only prayer is the deepest yearning of our hearts, the Holy Spirit is at work, carrying the whole of who we are into the heart of God.

There are many faithful ways to pray. We can begin and end the day with a simple "Thank you, Lord" or "Help me, Lord." We can pray the Lord's Prayer slowly, letting each petition shape our concerns for the world. We can read a psalm aloud, keep a gratitude journal, sit in silent prayer, sing a hymn, light a candle, pray while walking, or pause before meals to remember that all we have is received from God's hand. Families may pray together at bedtime; friends may pray over the phone; congregations pray in worship as the body of Christ. We can pray while woodworking, gardening, coloring, and paying attention to our senses. Any activity that can draw our attention to God's presence and help us feel connected to God can become a way of prayer.

Pastor's words - Continued

Prayer also forms us and sends us back into daily life. As we bring our neighbors, enemies, leaders, church, and world before God, the Spirit forms us for compassion, forgiveness, courage, and bold, faithful service. "Pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17) does not mean we must always have our eyes closed, hands folded, and say elaborate prayers; it means that every part of life can become open to God's presence. In work and rest, joy and grief, ordinary errands and holy worship, prayer keeps turning our hearts toward Christ - and toward the neighbors Christ calls us to love.

I invite you to find a way to experiment with your prayer life as a way of growing in faith. Try a new prayer practice. Pray for things you haven't before. Be willing to let the God who knows you deeper into your day to day activities. If you have questions about prayer, Pastor Nathan and I would LOVE to sit and have a conversation with you! Together, may we learn and grow through prayer this season!

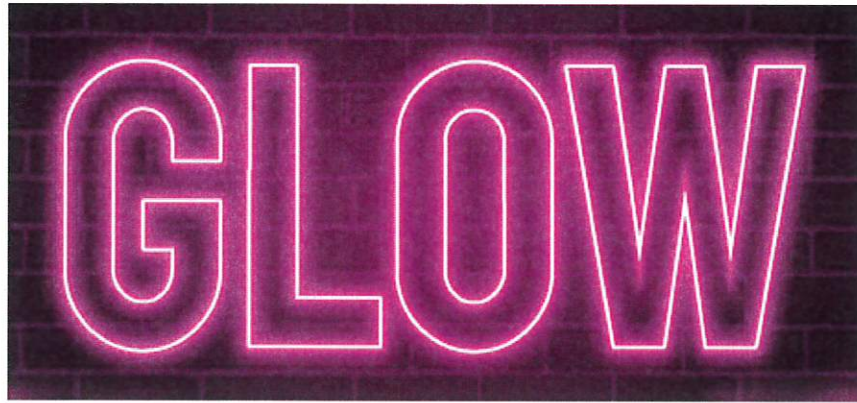

SUMMARY OF IMMANUEL COUNCIL MINUTES – July 2, 2026

PASTORS' REPORTS: Pastor Nathan reported the Steering Committee met and discussed how the Shared Ministry was going and the financial situation. He urged Council to say if there are things that need to be changed. Pastor Dan went to the Website *mmanuelcresco.com* and showed how people could now give on-line. Pastor Dan and Pastor Nathan will attend the Rostered Ministers Gathering in Indianapolis, Indiana.

MISSION CONVERSATION: The proposed new mission statement is “By God’s grace Immanuel Lutheran Church is a faith community striving to love and serve as disciples of Jesus.” Motion passed that the recommended mission statement be put on the July Semi-Annual Meeting agenda for a vote.

NEW BUSINESS: The following will be put on the July Semi-Annual Meeting agenda:

1. the Nominating Committee submission of names of persons to serve on the Council,
2. discussion of retaining the Choral Benediction at the end of worship service and
3. Pastor Dan and Pastor Nathan’s informative presentation on Immanuel’s connection to the Northeastern Iowa Synod and the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America.

Two lease proposals for a new copy machine were presented. Motion passed to accept the 5-year lease with Access Systems.

The Shared Ministry of Immanuel, Orleans and Peace is working well.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: The Endowment/Memorial Committee proposes spending \$2,472.00 of Endowment interest as follows: Howard County Child Care Solutions \$824.00, Lutheran Services in Iowa \$824.00 and Doctors Without Borders \$824.00. They also propose spending \$1,248.69 out of the Vobr account in the Memorial Fund to buy an adjustable piano bench. Motion passed to approve the distribution.

Council went into closed session.

BOARD REPORTS:

Stewardship & Finance – The board reviewed their duties listed in the handbook.

Worship & Music – The board has updated the “Planning Your Wedding” and “Funeral Dinner Guidelines”. These two instructional booklets will be presented at the next council meeting for approval.

Church Properties – The board removed the weeds on the east side of the church, applied Roundup on the parking lot, patched holes with concrete and consulted with the City of Cresco about the storm water collecting in the street in front of the church. Some windows have shifted down and created a gap. The janitor’s salary will be discussed at the next meeting.

Evangelism & Social Concerns – Every Wednesday morning volunteers have been sorting recently dropped off clothing in preparation for the Back to School Clothing Giveaway July 30th, 31st and August 1st.

Christian Education – The GLOW curriculum is in digital form. The church will print it.

Parish Fellowship – The board have completed the review of their handbook. On Sunday, July 12th there will be Bible Study at 5:00 p.m. Then at 6:00 p.m. there will be a Root Beer Float/Ice Cream Social hosted by Immanuel and in association with Orleans and Peace.

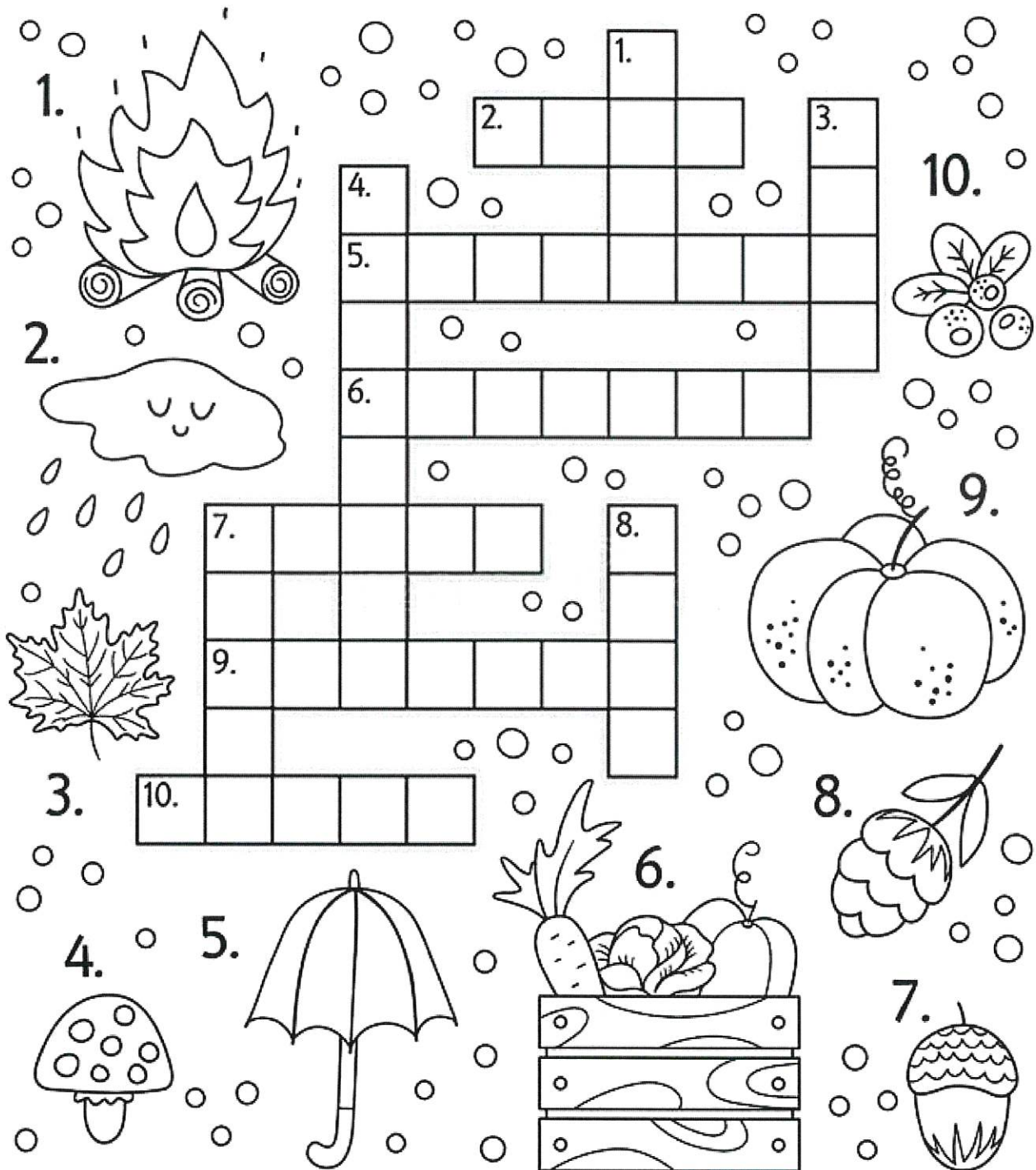
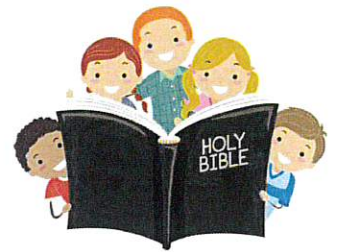
