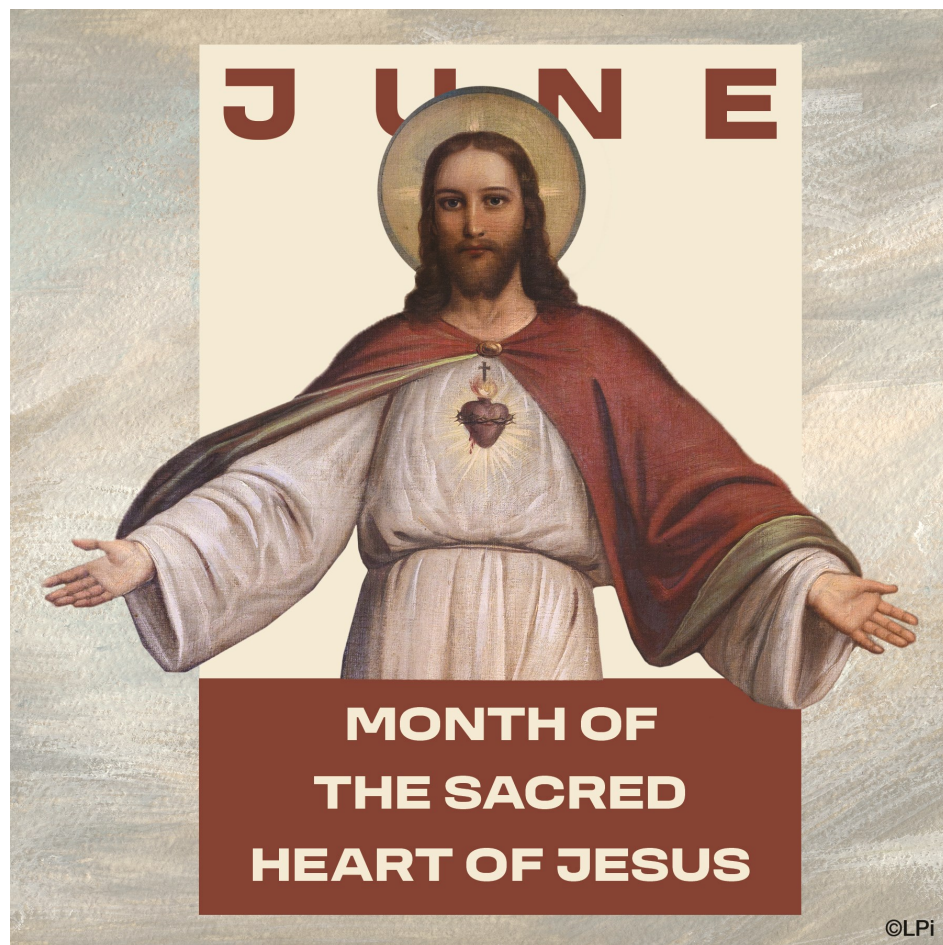

Dear Parish Community:

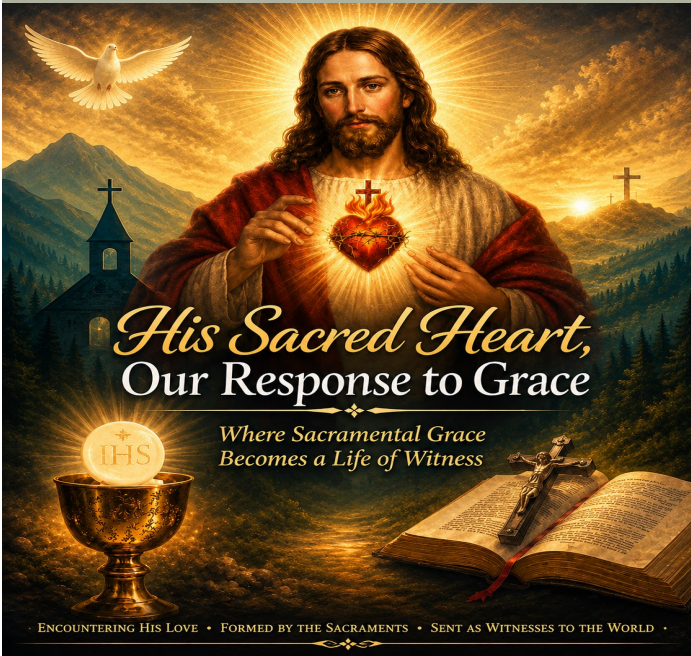

*“I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I love you.”*  
— John 15:11–12

Today, our Five Mountains Catholic Community gathers as one family in Christ to celebrate our shared Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

For the past weeks, we have prayed, reflected, pondered, and practiced lives of mercy. We have journeyed together toward the Heart of Christ.

On June 12, Catholics across the United States united in Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Today, we celebrate that same call within our local parish family — entrusting ourselves, our homes, our community, and our future to the loving Heart of Christ.

Consecration is not the end of a journey. It is a beginning. To live consecrated to the Sacred Heart means:

- choosing mercy daily,
- loving sacrificially,
- serving joyfully,
- forgiving generously,  
and remaining rooted in Christ.

The Sacred Heart reminds us that the Church is not simply a building or organization. The Church is a family gathered around the love of Jesus.

As Five Mountains Catholic Community continues growing together, may we become known for compassion, unity, prayer, hospitality, mercy, and faithful discipleship.

## Reflection

The Sacred Heart of Jesus burns with love for every person. That love is meant to transform not only individuals, but entire communities.

When families pray together, mercy grows.

When parishioners serve together, unity grows.

When forgiveness replaces division, Christ becomes visible.

The Heart of Jesus calls each of us beyond isolation into communion.

Our world deeply needs witnesses of hope.

People are searching for belonging, healing, peace, and purpose.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus offers all of these.

As consecrated disciples, we are called to carry His Heart into our homes, workplaces, schools, neighborhoods, and parish life.

Mercy must continue beyond this consecration day.

- What part of my life do I still need to surrender more fully to Jesus?

Today we consecrate ourselves to You.

Receive our families, our parish community, our joys, our wounds, and our future.

Make our hearts more like Yours.

Teach us to love with compassion, serve with humility, forgive with mercy, and walk together in unity.

May our Five Mountains Catholic Community become a living witness of Your love in the world.

Remain with us always, Lord Jesus,

and lead us ever deeper into Your Sacred Heart. Amen.

- Continue practicing one Work of Mercy each week.

- Pray daily: “Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in You.”

- Invite someone back to Mass or parish life.

May this consecration continue bearing fruit long after this celebration day.

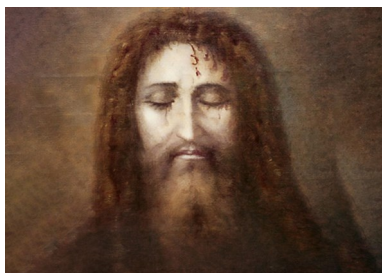
