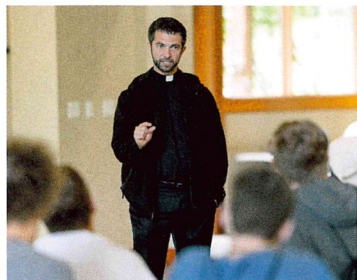

## PASTOR'S LETTER

# SPIRITUAL PREPARATION WORKSHOP

By the grace of God, this coming May 8th, our parish family—gathered at the Church of Saint John the Evangelist—will host a workshop designed to prepare us for the 33-day journey towards our Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in communion with our Archdiocese of Seattle. A spiritual workshop is a practical, participatory group activity designed to explore one's inner life, foster personal growth, and deepen one's connection with the sacred. The primary intention is not necessarily to become a "mystic," but rather to acquire tools for navigating the chaos of daily life with greater peace—focusing on the "doing" through guided exercises that facilitate introspection and experiential learning. Reflections, conversations, and moments of community are shared, helping participants see themselves reflected in the experiences of others. It serves as a compass to help you find your own path—that life journey leading toward God. Unlike a spiritual retreat—which entails the physical act of stepping away from one's daily routine and traveling to a tranquil setting (such as a country house or monastery) for several days to withdraw from external noise—the workshop constitutes the specific working methodology employed during that time. A retreat may consist of various specialized workshops covering topics such as forgiveness, inner peace, prayer, or—as in our case—consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It helps you identify those things that are currently occupying the space rightfully belonging to spirituality. To love as the Heart of Jesus loves, one must sometimes first heal one's own heart. Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is not merely a formal act or a one-time prayer; it is a vow of love and a surrender of the will. For this reason, participating in a preparatory workshop is essential: one cannot wholeheartedly offer what one does not first know or value. A workshop allows you to transition from theological theory to personal experience. It is not merely a matter of knowing the history of the apparitions to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, but of understanding what it means for that Heart to be "wounded by indifference" within the context of your own life today. Jesus made specific promises to those who would practice this devotion (peace in families, consolation in times of sorrow, and blessings in one's endeavors). The workshop teaches you that these promises are not "magic," but rather the fruits of a living relationship. This preparation teaches you how to cultivate that relationship so that these promises may blossom. Spirituality requires habit. Generally, the workshop facilitates self-knowledge—such as recognizing one's own faults and the need for forgiveness—as well as knowledge of Jesus, gained through meditation on His humanity, His self-giving, and His mercy; finally, it leads to the act of total consecration—the formal moment in which

one says to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: "Take my freedom, my memory, my understanding, and my will." A workshop trains you in daily prayer, for it exercises the spiritual muscle necessary to sustain your consecration beyond the day of the ceremony; it also aids in the work of reparation, as it helps us understand that our actions—expressed through charity and justice toward others—can "console" that Sacred Heart. The workshop serves as the period of "courtship" preceding the wedding; it is the time when you ensure that your "yes" is fully conscious, free, and filled with enthusiasm. Without such preparation, the act of consecration risks remaining nothing more than a signed document; with it, however, it transforms into a way of life. The workshop—designed to guide you through the 33 days of preparation for consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus—functions as a kind of "retreat in daily life." This specific number is chosen because it traditionally represents the 33 years of Jesus' life on Earth, symbolizing the complete journey of His existence—a journey you seek to imitate and to which you strive to unite yourself. It is not merely a matter of reciting an extra prayer, but rather a process of interior transformation—typically divided into stages serving as thematic blocks—designed to gradually "soften" and prepare the heart. These basic elements—consisting of readings, meditations, prayer, and specific tasks—will take you approximately 15 to 20 minutes each day. The process concludes on Day 34 (the specific feast day chosen for the consecration). This day holds special significance, as it is recommended that you seek the Sacrament of Confession (so that the Heart of Jesus may find a "clean home"), attend the Eucharist, and formally recite the Act of Consecration—a covenant of love through which you entrust your life, your family, and your concerns to Him. We may conclude, therefore, that the journey toward consecration is not an isolated event, but rather a process of profound reordering of one's personal life; for this period of preparation constitutes a conscious "Yes"—a moment of realization that this spiritual workshop is not a rite of perfection, but one of humility. Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus marks the beginning of a new identity. The workshop and the 33 days of preparation serve as the scaffolding supporting the construction of an intimate, steadfast, and transformative relationship—one that ultimately seeks to ensure that your heart beats in perfect rhythm with that of Jesus.

#### A Critical Distinction

This form of giving is separate from both parish stewardship and the Annual Catholic Appeal. Gifts to Catholic Charitable Initiatives do not support the operating budgets of St. John the Evangelist or the Archdiocese of Seattle.

Instead, this type of giving extends our generosity beyond local and regional needs to serve the wider Church and the world.

#### A Personal Call to Generosity

While the Church and archdiocese promote many worthy collections, parishioners are encouraged to prayerfully support the outreach efforts that align with their personal passions for service—such as St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital, Habitat for Humanity, or other charitable works that reflect Christ’s compassion.

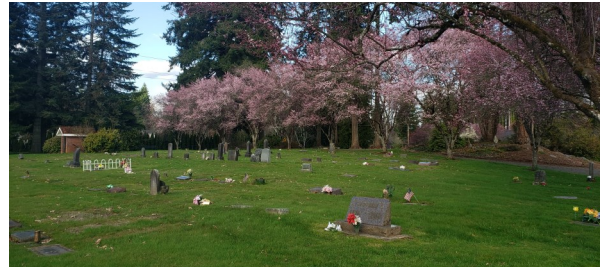

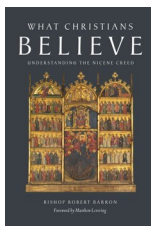

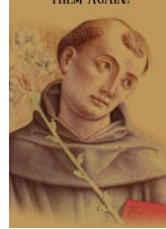
