THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

The Resurrection of the Lord was one of the most momentous events in history. By rising from the dead to return to eternal power at the right hand of the Father, Jesus fulfilled a vital part of the plan of God that has paramount importance to the life and future of every human being.

Let's dive deeply into this subject to try to understand more fully what the truth of Jesus Christ's resurrection should mean to us.

It was necessary that Jesus should rise again in order to manifest the justice of God. For it was most fitting that He who was degraded and loathed with ignominy through obedience to God, should have been exalted by God.

Furthermore, he rose with the purpose of confirming our faith, which is necessary for our justification. For the resurrection of Christ from the dead by his own power gives our faith its principal argument for his divinity.

The Resurrection also shows us that the sacrifice of Christ was acceptable to the Father, and serves a sign of the ratification of the New Covenant.

It also nurtures and sustains our hope, for, as Christ rose again, we are established in the certain hope that we too shall rise again. The members must necessarily arrive at the condition of their head. "Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By His great mercy we have been born anew to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Pt 1:3).

Finally, the resurrection of our Lord was necessary to complete the mystery of our salvation and redemption. For Christ liberated us from the slavery of sin by His death and restored to us through his resurrection the most important privileges which we had lost by sin. Hence the Apostle Paul teaches: "Jesus was to put the death for our trespasses and raised for our justification" (Rm 4:25).

Therefore, so that nothing be wanting to perfect the work of our salvation, it was necessary that, as he died, he should also rise again from the dead.

Jesus loves us all so much That He would bleed and die He took upon His beaten back The cross that saw Him crucified


Yes, He loved us all so much That He was scorned and scoffed He took it all upon Himself For it was the will of God

ST CATHERINE OF SIENA April 29th Virgin and Doctor of the Church



Raised in the medieval walled city of Siena in the Tuscan region of Italy, young Catherine was inspired by a great love of the Lord. She dedicated her life to prayer and penance, knowing that it was not so much a matter of what she could accomplish, but what God could accomplish in her. Despite being a young lay woman, with little formal education, her hope, integrity, and wisdom prevailed. Her works in spiritual theology arose from her love of the subject. Her dedication to the truth won the day. In 1970, she was named a Doctor of the Church for the profundity of her spiritual texts.

St. Catherine's life was marked by charity in its two great manifestations: Love of God and love of neighbor. She cared for the poor and fed the hungry from her own table. She nursed plague victims when all else abandoned them. In a mystical vision, she exchanged hearts with our Lord. Such was and is the Love of Jesus that he wishes to share the love of his own Sacred Heart - that Heart of Fire - with each one of us. On fire with that love,

St. Catherine knew that more was possible. She need not accept the status quo. Truth is possible. Beauty is possible. Goodness is possible. And so, we ask St. Catherine's intercession as we educate a new generation, for this world and for the next.

"We were enclosed, O eternal Father, within the garden of your breast. You drew us out of your holy mind like a flower petaled with our soul's three powers and into each power you put the whole plant, so that they might bear fruit in your garden, might come back to you with the fruit you gave them. And you would come back to the soul, to fill her with your blessedness. There the soul dwells like the fish in the sea and the sea in the fish".




