The beginning of the school year: Making all things new (Back to school)

It's that time of year, again, the hallways are lined with bookbags full of binders still blank of the doodles of summer boredom and the good old marble-covered notebooks, yet unsullied. Pencils have been sharpened, erasers are not yet lost, and sandwiches and snacks are tucked into their reliable spots. The kids are going back to school in their uniforms.

If Christmas is heralded as the "most wonderful time of the year," these first days of a new school year might be called the most "bracing" — and it all brings with its feelings of such hope and possibility, tempered with just a little fear: What new challenges are before us, and how we will meet them?

Many of us benefited from a Catholic education. Now we focus here on the work of our St. Catherine Catholic School. There are so many success stories and hard-working teachers and parents who believe in the Good News of Catholic education and struggle to find fresh, creative ways to keep our School alive and flourishing!

Certainly not every young person can or does enjoy their Catholic education — every generation has its malcontents (and they are usually, and reliably, unhappy about all schools, in general). Yet despite tales of uniforms and "strict teachers" and "prayers before everything" St. Catherine Catholic School has been and continues to be valuable; our School offers sound, affordable alternatives to families whose children are trapped in failing, or even dangerous, other schools.

It is true that our Parish relies on the school for great faith formation and youth ministry programs — from preschool through 8th grade. It is a dynamic tool of evangelization within the church itself.

But for a number of non-Catholic students, our school is becoming an invaluable source of public formation, training up a thoughtful, able citizenry capable of thinking critically and within broad perspectives, throughout the country.

Our memories of catholic schools are still vivid and warm. Part of that memory is attending Mass. May processions, what seemed never-ending recitations of the rosary during May, a tight and warm community and, of course, the good teachers and staff.

Many things have changed over the years. Still, the mission of a Catholic school is the same as that of the church: to proclaim that Jesus Christ is the way, the truth and the life, and to help us to live out the Gospels in our families and our communities.

Any school will reflect something of the society in which we are all part — a society that is often restless, hurt, living without hope. We live in a world that believes if we increase our income or have lots of toys, the truth of who we are will be made clear. And yet, we Catholics know that is not true — that the man-made material things do not matter. And our Catholic school understands that the God-hewn human mind, when taught to wonder (even amid scholastic disciplines), can transcend our worldly concerns and assist the Lord in healing and helping to make "all things new."

Please pray for all the educators and parents who dedicate themselves to preserving and adapting Catholic schools for our time and for the future. Pray for our School to be built by the generosity of those who know their lifelong impact. And as the new school year begins, may God bless and keep us all.

Lord, make our hearts pure as we prepare for the return of students to this school, and may you guide them to return with open hearts and minds eager to learn.


We ask this in Your name, Amen Dear Friends and Supporters of St. Catherine Catholic School,



SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL


This week we served 20 visitors/shoppers with a total of 51 family members. 10 volunteers operated the food pantry. We received 3 donations from Parish families.
