Dear Pastors/Administrators/Parochial Vicars,

As the Church anticipates the great liturgical celebrations of All Saints Day and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, it is my hope that these days will be grace-filled.

With this letter, I wish to inform you of the "Called By Name" campaign, which the Diocese of Venice will begin at the Sunday Masses of November 15-16. This special campaign is intended to identify young men from within the Diocese of Venice whom God could be calling to the priesthood.

In a recent article, the Wall Street Journal identified a growing problem within the Catholic Church, which is a decline in the number of men coming forward to become priests. Within our own Diocese, there is certainly a need for more men to answer the call to serve in the vineyard of the Lord. It is essential for future priestly vocations to come from our parishes and schools, and the assistance of the whole Church is needed to identify these vocations. *Called by Name* has recently been carried out by several other Dioceses with great success, and the same positive result can occur in the Diocese of Venice with the strong collaboration of our own parishes.

Included with this letter is a campaign overview, which will show how parishes can roll out the campaign, in addition to sample bulletin blurbs, Prayers of the Faithful, pulpit announcements, and homily prompts, which can be for the Sunday Masses of November 15-16. It is also encouraged for priests to share their own vocational story and the joy of the priesthood during the homily. It is often stated that the joyful witness of a priest, and especially the personal invitation of a priest, is a significant factor for a young man in hearing God's call to the priesthood.

 The witness you give to the priesthood of Jesus Christ and your efforts taken to carry out this important campaign for the Diocese of Venice is greatly appreciated.

I take this opportunity to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers for you and your ministry.
