## CATHOLIC SCHOOL WEEK

The 2026 theme “Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community” highlights why Catholic schools are vital today: they form young people as disciples of Jesus, serve families and parishes, and offer a distinctly faith-filled alternative to a secular culture.

### ## 2026 theme and focus

- The national theme through 2026 is \*\*\*“Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community,”\*\* stressing that Catholic schools are communities of faith, not just academic institutions.

- The theme underlines that Christ is the foundation of Catholic education and that schools, families, and parishes are united in one mission of evangelization and formation.

### ## Why Catholic schools matter

- Vatican II teaches that a Catholic school creates a Gospel-centered atmosphere of freedom and charity, orders all learning to the message of salvation, and helps students grow fully as baptized sons and daughters of God.

- The Church describes Catholic schools as a “privileged environment” for integral formation of the whole person—body, mind, and spirit—so that faith illuminates every subject, relationship, and decision.

### ## Mission: evangelization and salvation

- Church teaching states that Catholic schools are part of the Church’s saving mission, helping students come to know, love, and follow Christ in a way they will not encounter in the same way elsewhere.

- A recent USCCB statement says the goal of Catholic education is the flourishing of each person and ultimately their salvation, forming students in humility, wisdom, and virtue for a life of service to God and others.

### ## Partnership with parents and parish

- The Church consistently affirms parents as the first and primary educators; Catholic schools exist to assist them, not replace them, by drawing families deeply into the life of the Church.


- Catholic Schools Week explicitly highlights daily themes such as “Celebrating Your Parish” and “Celebrating Your Community,” making visible the bond between school, parish, and wider community.

### ## Witness in a secular culture

- Historically, Catholic schools arose to protect and hand on the faith amid pressures that could lead young people away from the Church; today they play a similar role in the face of aggressive secularism.

- The US bishops emphasize that Catholic schools transmit a unique vision of life in Jesus Christ, form good citizens for society, and provide a “ladder” for the poor and marginalized through high-quality education.


