**ASH WEDNESDAY**

Ash Wednesday publicly tells the truth about our smallness, sin, and dependence on God: “Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return.” Ash Wednesday is a kind of “sacramental intervention” if we approach ashes naming the problem plainly: “I have an inordinate love of self; I avoid saying ‘sorry’ and ‘thank you’ to God.”

The traditional formula (“you are dust...”) shatters the illusion that we are self-made or self-sufficient, grounding us in our createdness and mortality before God. Our “spiritual arrogance” makes us worry more about how we appear than how we are; Ash Wednesday invites the opposite—truthful exposure of our weakness to God. The visible ash on the forehead replaces curated image with a public sign of sin and need for mercy, a small but sharp blow to the ego’s desire to look flawless.

When you receive ashes and hear “Remember you are dust...”, consciously contradict the script (“I am the center”) with a quiet response like: “I am dust, loved dust, and not the center.” Accept the ashes as a public sign of need, resisting the urge to curate how you look or compare your ashes to others; this is a first, small blow to image-management.

Being told “you are dust” recalls Genesis and the expulsion from Eden, reminding us that everything we have is gift and that without God we return to nothing. To “repent in dust and ashes” in biblical language means fully humbling oneself and surrendering everything to God, which directly opposes self-assertion. One helpful interior response is: “I am dust, loved dust,” holding together radical lowliness and radical beloved-ness, rather than swinging between self-exaltation and self-contempt.

**Preparation for Confession**

Before: Ask for light: “Lord, show me where I refuse to admit fault, where I use others, where I need admiration.” Make a brief written inventory focused on patterns: domineering, lack of empathy, manipulation, contempt, using religion or ministry to feel superior.

During: Confess not just isolated acts but the pattern: “I have been making myself the center and using people/God to serve my ego.” Name specifically the refusal to say “I was wrong” and “I’m sorry,” since shame often keeps us away from Confession.

After: Accept penance without bargaining or explaining; obedience here is a concrete act against control and self-justification. Make one small repair each week of Lent (apology, listening without defending, giving up the last word) as a practical sign of repentance.




