

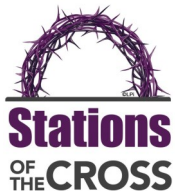

### Return to the Lord: Lenten Confession

Lent is a sacred time to turn back to God with all our hearts and to prepare for the joy of Easter. In these forty days, the Church invites us not only to pray, fast, and give alms, but also to seek God's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In confession, we come before the Lord with honesty and trust, asking Him to heal what is broken and to renew us in His grace.

Pope Francis reminds us that confession is not a "torture chamber," but an encounter with the mercy of the Father, who never tires of forgiving. In the quiet of the confessional, Christ Himself meets us, lifts the burdens we carry, and speaks words of forgiveness and peace through the ministry of the priest. Lent is a privileged moment to experience this mercy in a deeper way and to allow God's love to reach the places in our lives that most need His light.

Some years ago, a parishioner shared how, after many years away from confession, he stopped by the church one quiet Lenten afternoon. He said he sat in the back, unsure if he should stay or leave. Finally, he decided, "I'll just talk to the priest—I don't even know where to begin." When he finished his confession, he described feeling as if a heavy backpack he had carried for years was suddenly taken off his shoulders. He did not leave the church as a perfect man, but as a forgiven son—lighter, freer, and filled with hope.

That is what the Lord desires for each of us.

Perhaps it has been a long time since your last confession, or you feel uncertain about what to do. Do not be afraid. The priest is there to help you and to guide you through the sacrament. What the Lord desires is a sincere heart that is willing to turn away from sin and to begin again with His grace. Even a small step toward Him is precious in His eyes.

This Lent, we warmly invite you and your family to make the Sacrament of Reconciliation part of your preparation for Easter. Come and experience the freedom of a forgiven heart and the joy of knowing you are deeply loved by God. "Return to me with all your heart" (Joel 2:12) is not just a Lenten slogan, but a personal invitation from the Lord to you.

Also at the Gala, I mentioned that St. Catherine Catholic School would begin the transition to Catholic Classical Education next year. The transition is a process that will take several years to ensure that it happens smoothly and effectively. Some of the highlights of Catholic Classical Education are:

- Emphasis on cultivating **wisdom, virtue**, and pursuit of **truth, goodness, and beauty** over narrow utilitarian or "college-and-career" preparation.
- Integration of faith across the curriculum, with a supernatural horizon — transmitting the "full truth" (natural and revealed).
- Return to time-tested methods: the **Trivium** (grammar, logic, rhetoric), study of great books, primary sources from Western civilization (including Church Fathers, Aristotle, Aquinas), Latin, and the **Quadrivium** (arithmetic, geometry, music, astronomy) joined with art, philosophy and sacred theology.
- Active, wonder-filled learning that forms the whole person (intellect, character, soul) rather than passive acquisition of fragmented modern "subjects."
- Countercultural stance against secular trends, technology overload, or ideological fads in modern education.

We are excited about this opportunity to share the Gifts of Christ with our students for generations to come.

**Teacher Retention** – I am delighted to share that 100% of our faculty has expressed their intention to return for the 2026-2027 school year. This unanimous commitment is a profound blessing and a testament to the strength of our school community.

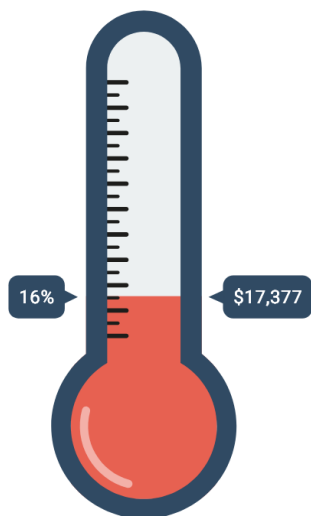
